Pro Career Highlights: Selected by the Fort Worth Flyers in the ten round (117th pick overall) of the 2006 NBA Developmental League Draft. Originally an early entry candidate for the 2005 NBA Draft before withdrawing his name from consideration.

College Highlights: Four-year player who was a part-time starter by his senior season. Started 48 of 99 career games.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 9.7 points and 3.4 rebounds in 28.1 minutes a contest. Started 15 of 16 games before missing the rest of the season due to a knee injury. Scored in double figures in nine of his last 12 games played. Posted season-high 15 points and five assists vs. Vanderbilt. Tallied 12 points, four rebounds, and four assists vs. LSU. Recorded 14 points, five rebounds, and three assists vs. Marquette. Scored 14 points in 12 minutes vs. Connecticut in his final appearance of the season.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 10.3 points and 4.3 rebounds in 25.1 minutes a contest. Started 18 of 31 games. Registered a career-high 23 points on 7-for-12 shooting vs. Dayton. Scored 18 points and grabbed a career-high nine rebounds vs. DePaul. Tallied 22 points, six rebounds, and five assists in the very next game vs. St. Louis, earning Conference USA Player of the Week honors. Recorded 14 points, seven rebounds, and career-high eight assists vs. Wake Forest. Scored 16 points vs. Memphis in the regular season finale.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 6.0 points and 2.6 rebounds in 18.7 minutes a contest. Started 15 of 28 games, missing four games due to a knee injury. Scored in double figures five times. Set season high with 12 points vs. Middle Tennessee State. Tallied ten points, five assists, and a career-high three steals vs. Dayton. Matched season-high with 12 points and added seven assists vs. Louisville in the Conference USA Tournament quarterfinals.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 3.4 points and 2.0 rebounds in 9.2 minutes a contest. Scored in double figures four times, with a season-high 18 points vs. UAB. Recorded 11 points vs. Marquette. Tallied ten points, seven rebounds, and a career-high three blocked shots vs. Gonzaga in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
