College Highlights: Finished collegiate career as the all-time leading free throw shooter (.946) in NCAA Division I history. Led the nation in free throw shooting his freshman, sophomore, and junior years. Earned First Team All-Missouri Valley Conference honors his junior and senior seasons. Ranks as Missouri State's seventh all-time leading scorer with 1,677 points.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged a team-high 15.4 points, 2.2 rebounds, and 2.1 assists. Ranked third in the nation in free throw shooting (.925). Started 32 of 33 games. Scored 20 or more points nine times. Shot 6-for-8 from the field, 4-for-4 from three-point range, and 10-for-10 from the line in scoring a season-high 26 points vs. Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Tallied 25 points vs. Wisconsin. Sank all 14 free throw attempts on his way to 23 points vs. Wichita State. Scored 22 points in the season opener vs. Toledo. Tallied 21 points, six rebounds, and four assists vs. Bradley. Posted 24 points vs. Drake.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged a team-high 16.2 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 2.5 assists. Started all 31 games. Scored 20 or more points 11 times, recording a career-high 32 points vs. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Hit six threes on his way to 27 points at Arkansas State. Shot 12-for-12 from the line in posting 25 points vs. Bradley. Scored 19 points and dished out a season-high seven assists vs. Northern Illinois.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 10.0 points in 20.9 minutes a contest. Tied own MVC record with 60 made free throws in a row. Started twice. Scored in double figures 12 times. Registered 27 points on 8-for-10 shooting, including five made threes at Creighton. Scored 23 points at Indiana State. Tallied 20 points and four assists vs. Troy. Posted 21 points and a season-high four rebounds vs. Drake.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 10.5 points in 21.9 minutes a contest. Set an NCAA Division I record for free throw percentage (117-for-120, .975). Had streaks of 60 (a MVC record) and 32 free throws made in a row. Started 19 of 33 games. Scored in double figures 16 times. Registered season-high 25 points at Evansville and scored 22 points in the rematch. Recorded 20 points vs. St. Louis. Earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and was the only freshman named on the league's All-Newcomer Team.

Personal: Majored in marketing. Father, Daniel, played collegiately at Washburn University.
