**Pro Career Highlights:** Spent the 2007-08 season in Romania with CS Otopeni Bucuresti, averaging 15.1 points and 7.6 rebounds in 14 games.

**College Highlights:** Earned Second Team All-Atlantic Sun honors as a junior and senior. Ranks as Belmont's second all-time leader in field goal percentage (.592), third in blocked shots (102), and third in rebounding average (6.3 rpg). Finished collegiate career at Belmont after playing first two seasons at Tennessee. Sat out the 2004-05 season at Belmont under NCAA transfer rules.

**Senior (2006-07):** Averaged 10.8 points and a team-high 5.2 rebounds in 16.5 minutes a contest. Led the Atlantic Sun Conference in field goal percentage (.622) and ranked second in blocked shots (1.4 bpg). Started seven times. Scored in double figures 16 times. Registered a season-high 24 points at Kennesaw State. Led team with 20 points at St. Mary's (Calif.). Posted a 11-point, ten-rebound double-double vs. Jacksonville. Shot 8-for-9 from the field in scoring 18 points at Jacksonville. Tallied ten points and a career-high eight blocked shots at North Florida.

**Junior (2005-06):** Averaged 14.6 points and 7.4 rebounds (ranked sixth in the Atlantic Sun) in 22.6 minutes a contest. Led the league in blocked shots (1.8 bpg) and ranked second in field goal percentage (.579). Started 19 of 31 games. Posted seven double-doubles. Scored 20 or more points five times. Set career-highs of 27 points, 16 rebounds, and four blocked shots at Kennesaw State. Tallied 23 points vs. Stetson. Matched season-high of 27 points and added 13 rebounds and four blocks at Mercer. Recorded a season-high-matching 27 points and added 14 rebounds at Campbell. Scored 18 points at Oklahoma.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** At Tennessee, averaged 1.6 points and 1.8 rebounds in 6.6 minutes a contest. Registered season highs of ten points, eight rebounds, and three blocked shots vs. The Citadel. Tallied eight points, seven rebounds, and two blocked shots vs. Tennessee Tech.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Averaged 1.3 points and 1.8 rebounds in 3.2 minutes a contest. Registered five points and seven rebounds vs. Massachusetts. Recorded two blocked shots vs. Georgetown in the post-season NIT.

**Personal:** Graduated with a bachelor's degree in communication studies.
