**Pro Career Highlights:** Participated in NBA training camp with the Denver Nuggets in the fall of 2007. Briefly played with the Great Falls Explorers in the CBA in 2006-07, appearing in four games and averaging 1.3 points and 3.5 rebounds in 12.3 minutes a contest. Played with Correcaminos Matamoros UAT in Mexico in 2001-02, averaging 18 points, 12 rebounds, and four blocked shots. Spent the summer of 2001 with the San Antonio Bombers in the SWBL (statistics unavailable).

**College Highlights:** Played one season at Georgia State after playing first two seasons at Texas A&M. Sat out one semester at Arizona State in 1997-98 as a transfer student before moving on to Georgia State, where he sat out the spring semester. Left Georgia State after the 1998-99 season to pursue a professional career.

**Junior (1998-99):** Averaged 3.9 points and 3.9 rebounds after becoming eligible to play after the first semester. Started twice.

**Sophomore (1996-97):** Averaged 3.5 points and 2.0 rebounds in 10.3 minutes a contest. Started five times. Scored in double figures three times, including a season-high 11 points at North Texas State. Tallied 11 points vs. Clemson and notched ten points at Nebraska. Pulled down season-high six rebounds twice, vs. Texas and at Oklahoma State.

**Freshman (1995-96):** Averaged 5.4 points and 2.8 rebounds in 17.2 minutes a contest. Started 12 of 22 games. Set season highs of 18 points and four blocked shots vs. Texas Tech. Grabbed a season-high eight rebounds vs. Rice.
