**College Highlights:** Named Third team All-Big East as a junior. Finished collegiate career as Georgetown's 12<sup>th</sup> all-time leading scorer with 1,548 points. Also ranks tenth in career rebounds with 739 and 14<sup>th</sup> in steals with 170. Stared all 126 games played at Georgetown. Member of the 2002 USA Team at the International Albert Schweitzer Youth Basketball Tournament in Mannheim, Germany.

**Senior (2005-06):** Ranked third on the team in scoring (11.0 ppg), third in rebounds (5.0 rpg) and first in steals (1.1 spg). Had two double-doubles. Scored 20 or more points three times and scored in double figures 20 times. Recorded a season-high 25 points in Big East Tournament win over Notre Dame. Tallied 23 points, eight rebounds, and three blocked shots vs. Duke. Registered 15 points and 11 rebounds vs. West Virginia. Scored 19 points and grabbed a season-high 12 rebounds in win vs. Providence. Posted 15 points, nine rebounds, and a career-high six assists vs. UTEP. Hit four three-pointers in a game twice, vs. Fairfield and St. John's.

**Junior (2004-05):** Led the team in scoring (15.1 ppg), steals (42), and was second in rebounding (6.1 rpg). Finished third in blocked shots (29). Posted four double-doubles. Scored 20 or more points six times. Recorded season-high 28 points in win vs. Penn State. Hit 14 of 15 free throws in a 25-point game vs. Seton Hall. Registered 22 points vs. Villanova. Tallied 22 points and ten rebounds at Clemson. Sank five threes in scoring 23 points and grabbing 13 rebounds vs. The Citadel.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** Led the team in rebounding (8.1 rpg) and blocked shots (37) while ranking second in scoring (15.9 ppg). Scored 20 or more points five times. Pulled down ten or more rebounds seven times and posted four double doubles. Scored a career-high 30 points vs. Delaware State. Scored 17 points and set a career-high in rebounds with 15 at Notre Dame. Tallied 20 points and nine rebounds at St. John's. Registered 17 points and 11 rebounds at Connecticut.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Averaged 7.6 points and 4.5 rebounds. Started all 34 games. Scored in double figures 11 times. Recorded a season-high 18 points vs. Norfolk State and vs. Syracuse in the Big East Tournament. Tallied 13 points and six rebounds vs. UCLA. Recorded 16 points at Pittsburgh. Scored 51 points in five NIT Tournament games. Pulled down a season-high 12 rebounds at Providence in the second round of the post-season NIT.

**Personal:** Majored in sociology with a minor in English. Has three brothers and a sister (Tom, Stephan, Zach, Nicole). Cousin of NBA players Antoine Walker and Samaki Walker.
