Senior (2007-08): Played in 31, earning 20 starts games averaging 12.0 points, 3.2 rebounds and 13.6 minutes per game ... Named MVP of the Seventh-Annual Ken Wright '52 Invitational ... Pioneer Valley Classic All-Tournament Team ... Part of the winningest class in Amherst history, with 111 wins in four seasons ... SESCAC Winter All-Sportsmanship selection ...30 points vs. RIC (2/5/08), 10 rebounds vs. Lasell (12/12/07) & vs. John Jay (3/8/08), 5 assists vs. Conn. (2/8/08), 4 blocks vs. Williams (1/12/08) & vs. Bates (1/19/08), 2 steals (several times).

Junior (2006-07): Played in 32 games as a Junior at Amherst College ... Averaged 4.6 points 2.9 rebounds in 10.7 minutes of action ... averaged .466 percent from the field (55-118), .214 from three-point range (3-14) and .714 percent from the foul line (35-49).

Sophomore (2006-07): In his second year at Amherst College, Jones played in 26 games and averaged 2.8 points in 6.3 minutes of action.

Freshman (2005-06): As a freshmen at Amherst College, Jones played in 11 games and averaged 1.4 points in 4.6 minutes of action.
