**Pro Career Highlights:** Played briefly with Liceo in Costa Rica in the summer of 2008, appearing in two games and averaging 21.5 points and 6.0 rebounds. Played with the Rio Grande Valley Silverados in the CBA in 2007-08, averaging 11.5 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 3.3 assists in six games. Started the 2006-07 season with the Utah Eagles in the CBA, averaging 3.7 points and 2.3 assists in 15 games. Finished the year in Romania with CSU Atlassib Sibiu (statistics unavailable). Also played with CSU Atlassib Sibiu in 2005-06, averaging 23.1 points and 4.2 assists.

**College Highlights:** Named NCAA Division I Independents Player of the Year as a senior. Finished collegiate career as Texas A&M-Corpus Christi's second all-time leading scorer with 1,274 points. Also ranks as the all-time leader in minutes played (3,402), free throws made (375), and assists (493).

**Senior (2003-04):** Averaged a team-high 12.4 points, 2.7 rebounds, and 4.5 assists. Started all 26 games. Scored 20 or more points four times, recording a season-high 25 points vs. Drake. Posted 21 points, six rebounds, and six assists at Texas A&M. Tallied 19 points and seven assists vs. Murray State. Registered 22 points vs. Sam Houston State. Dished out a season-high nine assists at Chicago State. Recorded 21 points, five rebounds, and six assists vs. Texas Southern.

**Junior (2002-03):** Averaged 13.9 points, 2.9 rebounds, and 4.6 assists. Started all 29 games. Scored 20 or more points five times. Posted season-high 27 points vs. Loyola-Chicago. Recorded 25 points and six assists at Hawaii. Scored 22 points at LSU and vs. Savannah State. Registered 24 points in the season opener at Cal State Fullerton. Tallied 18 points, a season-high seven rebounds, and seven assists at Lamar. Notched an 18-point, career-high ten-assist double-double at Sam Houston State.

**Sophomore (2001-02):** Averaged 13.5 points, 3.3 rebounds, and 4.5 assists. Started 25 of 26 games. Scored 20 or more points six times. Registered career-high 31 points vs. Texas-Pan American. Tallied 21 points and a season-high nine assists vs. Arkansas State. Scored 22 points and dished out five assists vs. South Florida. Recorded 20 points and eight assists vs. Gardner-Webb. Recorded 27 points vs. Centenary and 23 points vs. Savannah State in the last two games of the season.

**Freshman (2000-01):** Averaged 7.1 points, 2.6 rebounds, and 4.5 assists. Started 22 of 28 games. Scored in double figures seven times. Set season highs with 16 points and eight assists at Texas Tech. Matched season high with eight assists at Texas-Pan American.
