Pro Career Highlights: Played for the Auckland Stars in New Zealand in the 2006 season. Averaged 12.9 points and 1.7 rebounds in 17 games. Led team in three-point field goals made (34) and ranked fourth on the team in scoring.

College Highlights: Finished career as Rice's 27th all-time leading scorer with 1,007 points. Also ranks fourth all-time in career three-point field goals made (171) and third in career three-point field goals attempted (500). Started 51 of 120 career games.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 9.3 points, 1.4 rebounds, and 1.6 assists in 24.4 minutes a contest. Started 17 of 31 games. Scored in double figures 17 times. Posted season-high 19 points on 7-for-9 shooting vs. Fresno State. Scored 15 points at Syracuse. Tallied 15 points and three assists at Fresno State. Hit three three-pointers in scoring 13 points vs. Tulsa. Registered ten points at Missouri State in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 9.2 points, 1.2 rebounds, and 1.5 assists in 24.7 minutes a contest. Led team and ranked seventh in the WAC in three-point field goals made (56). Started all 33 games. Scored in double figures 15 times. Posted season-high 20 points twice, at Louisiana Tech and vs. SMU. Recorded 13 points vs. Stanford. Tallied 12 points vs. Connecticut. Registered 16 points vs. Nevada.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 9.4 points, 1.3 rebounds and 1.2 assists in 18.5 minutes a contest. Came off the bench in all 28 games. Scored in double figures 13 times, with a season-high 19 points at UTEP. Tallied 18 points vs. Houston. Sank five threes in scoring 14 points at Navy. Dished out a season-high four assists at Nevada.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 5.4 points, 0.9 rebounds, and 0.8 assists in 11.2 minutes a contest. Made 28 appearances and started once. Recorded career-high 23 points vs. UTEP. Tallied 17 points vs. Boise State. Registered season-high five assists vs. Tulsa.

Personal: Had a bit part in the movie "Glory Road" as a basketball player for Eastern New Mexico. Father, Marty, played at Iowa State in the 1970's.
