Anaheim Arsenal: 22 games, 16 starts: 4.6 ppg, 4.8 rpg, ... February signed with Union Shops Rastatt (Germany-2.Bundesliga, starting five), 4 games: 11.3 ppg, 12.0 rpg, 1.8 bpg ... signed with ratiopharm Ulm (Germany-1.Bundesliga, starting five) ... 2007-08: July: NBA Summer League in Las Vegas (Los Angeles Lakers) ... Anaheim Arsenal (D-League) training camp, left in December (DNP) ... 2008-09: Signed with Puente Alto C.D. Santiago (Chile-DIMAYOR, starting five) ... in January signed with Anaheim Arsenal (D-League): 8 games: 2.9 ppg, 4.4 rpg, left in February due to injury ... Vancouver Volcanoes (IBL, starting five) ... 2009-10: July, Korean KBL Pre-Draft Camp in Las Vegas, NV ... NBA Summer League in Las Vegas (Dallas Mavericks) ... Senior (2005-06): Appeared in all 28 games, including six starts...averaged 2.6 points and 1.6 rebounds in 7.8 minutes per game...was second on the squad with 18 blocks... owned a team-best field goal percentage of 61.7% (29-for-47) from the floor...grabbed at least five rebounds in four of his six starts...recorded at least one field goal in his last 11 games...made his first career start against Winthrop (2/18/06) and responded with a, then, career-high eight points and six rebounds...averaged 4.6 points and 4.5 rebounds in his six starts...posted a career-best nine points and six rebounds on 4-for-8 shooting in an 80-70 triumph over Central Michigan on Feb. 22...scored seven points in six minutes in a 80-78 win over San Jose State (12/29/05)...collected seven points and five boards in 10 minutes of action in a 102-61 win over Aurora (11/26/05).

Junior (2004-05): Dished out a career high two assists in eight minutes of playing time at Toledo (2/12/05), before grabbing two boards in seven minutes at Eastern Michigan (2/16/05) ... Scored two points and grabbed two boards in a season-high nine minutes at Wright State (2/19/05) in the ESPN Bracket Buster ... Saw his first collegiate action in nearly a year with one minute of playing time at Loyola (11/20/04) ... Returned to action vs. Akron in the MAC-opener and scored two points on a fast break lay-up.

Sophomore (2003-04): Underwent a pair of knee surgeries, the first in mid- October, and the second on Feb. 18, to help repair a right-knee injury sustained during off-season workouts prior to the start of the 2003-04 season ... Never healed properly after the first surgery and played in six games before undergoing the second arthroscopic surgery on Feb. 18 ... Averaged 1.0 points and 1.2 rebounds in those six outings ... Played a season high 10 minutes against St. Francis (Dec. 30), scoring two points and grabbing a career high four rebounds ... Played eight minutes against Cornell College (Feb. 15), scoring a career high four points on 2-of-3 shooting ... Also netted three boards ... Played one MAC contest against Ohio (Jan. 3).

Freshman (2002-03): Played in 24 games ... Ended the season fifth on the squad with eight blocked shots. Saw first action in a Northern Illinois uniform with seven minutes against Wisconsin (11-16-02) at the NABC Classic ... Notched first collegiate rebound, assist and block in that contest ... Set a career-high with three rejections in just four minutes of play against Illinois-Chicago (12-28-02) while scoring his first collegiate points. Got in for a season-best 12 minutes at Toledo (1-8-03).
