College Highlights: Played in 136 at Oklahoma State averaging 10.3 points, 11.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game ... became the first Big 12 player in history to record 1,250 points, 500 assists and 250 steals in a career ... first player in school history to record 50 or more steals in each of his four seasons ... tied for second place on the Big 12 career free-throws made list.

Senior (2008-09): Named the All-Big 12 Third Team in a vote by the league coaches ... Averaged 14.3 points in 35 games as a senior.

Junior (2007-08): Named All-Big 12 Third Team by the league coaches ... Owns the school record for career steals with 190. ... scored a career-high 26 points in a 61-60 upset win over No. 4 Kansas on Jan. 23 ... twice matched his career rebounding high of eight ... matched his career high with seven steals against Prairie View A&M in the season opener

Sophomore (2006-07): Started 23 games for Oklahoma State, including all four post-season games ... scored a career-high 25 points at Nebraska, going 9-of-12 from the floor, including 5-of-7 from beyond the three-point arc ... dished out a season-high eight assists on three occasions ... became just the second Cowboy in school history to record 100 assists in both his freshman and sophomore seasons.

Freshman (2005-06): started 28 games as a true freshman, the second-most in school history by a freshman ... just the fourth true freshman in the Eddie Sutton era to start the season opener of his first collegiate year ... recorded the first double-double of his career with 11 assists and 10 points against Mercer on Dec. 18 ... scored a career-high 18 points in the quarterfinal loss to Kansas in the Big 12 Tournament ... connected on 5-of-6 shots from beyond the arc in the game vs. the Jayhawks ... set a school record for steals by a freshman with 67... established a school mark for freshmen with seven steals against Oklahoma on Feb. 27.

Personal: Son of Latorra Eaton. He has two younger sisters, Ashley and Patricia. Byron has a son, Byron, Jr., born June 30, 2006 ... He enjoys playing football and basketball, as well as spending his free time with his younger sisters.
