**Pro Career Highlights:** Played with the Rome Gladiators in the WBA in the summer of 2006, earning Second Team All-League honors and All-Defensive Team mention. Played with the Indianapolis Alley Cats in the ABA in 2005-06. Spent the summer of 2005 with the Dayton Jets in the IBL, averaging 15.3 points.

**College Highlights:** Earned First Team All-West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference honors his sophomore, junior, and senior seasons. Named Second Team All-East Region by Daktronics as a senior. Finished collegiate career as Charleston's fifth all-time leading scorer with 2,092 points.

**Senior (2003-04):** Ranked third in the WVIAC in scoring (23.5 ppg). Started 20 of 24 games. Scored 30 or more points four times. Posted season-high 34 points and grabbed ten rebounds vs. Fairmont State, his only double-double of the season. Recorded 32 points, eight rebounds, and four assists vs. Shepherd. Tallied 30 points on 12-for-19 shooting vs. Cincinnati-Clermont. Scored 29 points at Glenville State. Tallied 24 points and five steals vs. Edinboro.

**Junior (2002-03):** Ranked second on the team in scoring (18.6) while leading the team in rebounding (7.7 rpg). Started all 31 games. Posted six double-doubles. Led team in scoring 12 times. Recorded 30 points vs. Concord. Tallied 26 points and 12 rebounds at Bluefield State. Recorded a double-double of 14 points and 11 rebounds at Shepherd. Registered 22 points and 12 rebounds at Concord. Scored 20 points and grabbed a season-high 13 rebounds at Ohio Valley.

**Sophomore (2001-02):** Averaged a team-high 16.4 points (ranked 15<sup>th</sup> in the WVIAC) and 7.7 rebounds (ninth). Started 30 of 32 games. Posted seven double-doubles. Registered a double-double of 22 points and 11 rebounds vs. Longwood. Recorded 19 points and a season-high 16 rebounds vs. Alderson-Broaddus. Scored 24 points vs. Fairmont State. Tallied a season-high 27 points and ten rebounds vs. Glenville State in the first round of the WVIAC Tournament.

**Freshman (2000-01):** Averaged 13.9 points and 7.2 rebounds. Ranked third in the WVIAC in field goal percentage (.593). Started 22 of 30 games. Scored a season-high 31 points vs. West Virginia State. Registered 23 points and a season-high 15 rebounds at West Virginia State. Posted a double-double of 26 points and ten rebounds vs. Fairmont State in the WVIAC Tournament semifinals. Earned Most Outstanding Player of the WVIAC Tournament. Named to the WVIAC All-Freshman Team.
