College Highlights: Named First Team All-Atlantic-10 as a senior. Earned Second Team honors as a junior. Named to the league All-Defensive Team as a sophomore. Earned an All-Rookie Team nod as a freshman. Finished collegiate career ranked second on George Washington's all-time leaders for assists (539) and steals (281). Also ranks 23rd all-time in scoring with X points.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 12.9 points and 3.6 rebounds while leading the Atlantic-10 in assists (4.8 apg) and steals (2.6 spg, ranked 12th nationally). Started 31 of 32 games. Registered career-high 29 points vs. Dartmouth. Posted 25 points and five rebounds in the season opener at Boston University. Grabbed a career-high seven steals vs. Maryland-Baltimore County. Dished out a season-high 11 assists at Dayton. Recorded the first triple-double in school history with 17 points, a career-high 12 rebounds, and ten assists vs. Temple. Led team with 17 points and six rebounds vs. Rhode Island in the championship game of the Atlantic-10 Tournament.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 11.5 points, 3.9 rebounds, 3.9 assists, and 2.3 steals. Started all 30 games. Posted season-high 20 points vs. St. Joseph's. Registered a double-double of 15 points and ten rebounds at Xavier. Scored 14 points and grabbed six rebounds at North Carolina State. Recorded 11 points vs. Maryland. Tallied 15 points, six rebounds, four assists, and three steals vs. UNC-Wilmington in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore (2004-05): Averaged 8.2 points, 3.8 rebounds, 3.2 assists, and 2.6 steals. Started all 30 games. Scored in double figures 11 times. Posted season-high 18 points vs. Dayton. Recorded 17 points, six rebounds, six assists, and four steals vs. Michigan State. Tallied 11 points, seven assists, and a season-high six steals vs. Towson. Handed out a season-high 11 assists at Duquesne. Scored 14 points and dished out six assists at Rhode Island.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 8.4 points, 3.8 rebounds, 4.3 assists, and 2.0 steals. Started 29 of 30 games. Scored in double figures 11 times. Scored season-high 18 points at St. Joseph's. Tallied 13 points and seven assists vs. West Virginia. Posted ten points, seven assists, and five steals vs. Gonzaga. Recorded first career double-double with 13 points and 12 rebounds at Texas. Registered a career-high 14 assists vs. St. Bonaventure.

Personal: Majored in sociology. Turned down a pair of Big Ten football scholarship offers to play basketball at George Washington.
