College Highlights: Started 42 of 46 career games at Cleveland State. Finished collegiate career at Cleveland State after playing first two seasons at Mott Community College in Michigan.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 8.6 points, 2.3 rebounds, and 4.1 assists (ranked third in the Horizon League). Started the first 18 games of the season before being declared academically ineligible. Posted season-high 21 points vs. West Virginia Tech. Tallied 14 points and a season-high seven assists at Central Michigan. Registered 14 points and six assists vs. Kent State. Notched 15 points vs. Miami (Fla.).

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 8.1 points, 1.7 rebounds, and 4.6 assists (fourth in the Horizon League). Started 24 of 28 games. Registered career-high 23 points and six assists vs. Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Led team with 18 points at Wright State. Recorded 15 points, nine assists, and four steals at Illinois-Chicago. Dished out a career-high 12 assists against only one turnover at Michigan State.

Sophomore (2004-05): At Mott CC, averaged 8.7 points, 6.3 assists, and 2.5 steals. Helped team to a 30-5 record and a second-place finish in the NJCAA district tournament.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 6.3 points, 4.9 assists, and 2.1 steals. Helped team to a 31-5 record.
