Professional Career: 2007-08: played briefly in Santa Barbara Breakers (IBL) ... October, Los Angeles D-Fenders training camp ... Drafted by Los Angeles D-Fenders (D-League,5rd(64)) ... Los Angeles D-Fenders (D-League, starting five): 43 games: 12.4 ppg, 2.7 rpg, 1.9 apg ... 2008-09: Drafted by Erie Bay Hawks (D-League Expansion Draft,6rd(11)) ... 2008-09: Etendard de Brest (France-ProB, starting five): 32 games: 15.4ppg, 2.9rpg, 2.5apg.

College Highlights: In six years (one redshirt and one medical hardship) at UC Santa Barbara, Brown played in 111 games averaging 8.7 points in 23.3 minutes per contest.

Senior (2006-07): awarded a sixth year of eligibility by the NCAA...He missed the 2001-02 and 2004-05 seasons because of injury ... Played in 24 games earning 14 starts and averaged 9.3 points in 28.9 minutes a game.

Junior (2005-06): named Second Team All-Big West selection after leading the Gauchos in scoring at 13.1 points per game...Had easily the best year of his career, averaging 3.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists to go along with his scoring average of 13.1 per game...Scoring average was slightly higher in Big West games at 13.2 per outing...Had career-highs in virtually every statistical category...In addition to leading the team in scoring, Brown ranked second on the team in three-pointers with 42...Played in 28 of the team's 29 games, starting 27...Missed a home game against Long Beach State with a sprained knee...Scored 10 or more points 23 times...Poured in a career-high 28 points on 11-of-17 shooting overall and 3-of-6 from beyond the three-point arc in a home win over Pepperdine... He was the only UCSB player to earn a Player of the Week honor during the season.

(2004-05): Brown missed the entire regular season with knee and ankle injuries...Played in the Gauchos' first exhibition game and then injured his knee in practice soon after...Brown was expected to return late in December, but he injured his ankle in practice the day before a mid-December game at San Diego and didn't return during the season.

Sophomore (2003-04): Brown ranked fourth on the Gauchos in scoring with 7.7 points per game...He was one of four UCSB players to score 200 or more points...Averaged 9.6 points per game in non-conference play and 6.8 per game in Big West games... Brown missed a game against Alabama State with a sprained ankle, the only game he missed during the season.

Freshman (2002-03): averaged 5.2 points per game as a freshman...Scored a total of 167 points...Played in all 32 games and started three of them...Averaged 5.4 points per game during Big West Conference play...Played a total of 519 minutes on the season...Averaged 16.2 minutes per game...Shot 39.3% from the floor on 57-of-145 shots...Drilled 22-of-64 three-point attempts to shoot 34.4% from behind the arc...Made 31-of-45 free throws on the season for a mark of 68%.

Personal: Nicknamed Quiet Storm...His hobbies include reading...His favorite novel is Brave New World and his favorite author is Aldous Huxley...Also played volleyball in high school...son of Emily Jester and Cecil Brown.
