Professional Career: 2006-07: July, Summer Pro-Am League in Long Beach (Team Game) ... Oita Heat Devils (Japan-BJ League, starting five) ... Oita Heat Devils (Japan-BJ League, starting five) ... 2008-09: spring: JBL League in Los Angeles (D.I.G.G.team) ... Ryukyu Golden Kings (Japan-BJ League, starting five): 54 games: 13.4 ppg, 7.4 rpg, 1.3 bpg. 2009-10: July, signed with Los Angeles Lightning (IBL).

Senior (2005-06): Capped off his four-year career at Loyola with 30 games averaging 5.7 points in 11.6 minutes per contest ... Ayer averaged 10.0 points per game in WCC play (ranked 18th) and 9.4 overall (22nd). This season he has had his first 20-point games of his career, including a career-best 22 against Northern Colorado and 21 against Western Michigan. Ayer ranked fifth in blocks per game (1.27), 10th in shooting percentage from the field (49.3), and seventh with 6.3 rebounds per game. Senior Chris Ayer had moved into second place all-time in the LMU record books for career blocks thanks to a single swat against USF. He has 38 on the year, ranking in a tie for seventh in single season blocks, and 110 in his career. The all-time record is held by Sherman Gay with 144.

Junior (2004-05): Finished his junior campaign with 3.3 points per game, 2.3 rebounds and 11.1 minutes played per game, the lowest of his career... added 14 blocks to his career total, which is fifth at LMU...

Sophomore (2003-04): Ayer played in all but one contest, missing the Long Beach State contest due to illness... averaged 19.9 minutes in 25 starts on the year... averaged 6.1 points and 5.5 rebounds per game... fifth in the WCC in blocks with 28... 58 blocks in his two-year career is ranked 10th all-time at LMU... played 32 minutes in the start against UC Riverside (11-21-03)... had a career-high 12 rebounds with eight points and three blocks in the win.

Freshman (2002-03): Ayer worked his way into the starting line-up and improved the last half of the season... started 15 of the final 16 games... finished with 30 blocks on the season, sixth in the WCC and the most by a freshman in LMU history... added 100 points and 79 rebounds... in first game at LMU against Loyola-Chicago (11-22-02) he scored nine points with five rebounds and two blocks... against Sacramento State (11-25-02) he scored five points in 10 minutes.

Personal: Son of Chris and Celia Ayer... has one brother, Craig... father played football at Ripon College (1967-71)...relative Chris Davis played professional baseball for the St. Louis Cardinals... majored in history with a minor in animation and political science.
