College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-SEC honors as a senior from the Associated Press and the league coaches. Ranks as Mississippi's sixth all-time leader in three-point field goals made (127). Finished collegiate career at Mississippi after playing first two seasons at Okaloosa-Walton Community College in Niceville, Florida.

Senior (2006-07): Led team and ranked fifth in the SEC in scoring (16.1 ppg). Started 26 of 34 games. Scored 20 or more points 11 times. Sank seven threes on his way to matching a caerer high with 29 points vs. LSU. Hit 7-for-11 from beyond the three-point arc in scoring 21 points at Auburn. Scored 18 points and dished out a season-high five assists at Memphis. Tallied 17 points and a season-high six rebounds at Mississippi State. Led team with 21 points vs. Florida in the semifinals of the SEC Tournament.

Junior (2005-06): Ranked second on the team in scoring (9.1 ppg). Started eight times. Scored in double figures ten times. Hit seven threes on his way to a career-high 29 points at Tennessee. Tallied 20 points and a season-high five assists vs. Arkansas State. Led team with 16 points and a season-high four steals vs. Florida. Tallied 16 points and five assists at Illinois-Chicago. Scored 13 points vs. Memphis.

Sophomore (2004-05): At Okaloosa-Walton CC, averaged 23.6 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 1.8 assists. Named Panhandle Conference Player of the Year.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged a team-high 18.3 points and 3.3 rebounds. Earned First Team All-State honors.
