**College Highlights:** Earned First Team All-Southland Conference honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career as the 12th all-time leading scorer in Northwestern State history with 1,388 career points. Also ranks seventh all-time in rebounds (722) and eighth in blocked shots (78). Started 114 of 117 games played. Recorded 13 career double-doubles.

**Senior (2005-06):** Led team in scoring (14.2 ppg) and rebounding (6.2 rpg). Paced team in scoring in 16 games. Scored 20 or more points four times, including a season-high 24 points at Oklahoma State. Registered 22 points vs. Sam Houston State in the Southland Conference Tournament championship game, on his way to Tournament MVP honors. Led team with 18 points vs. Iowa in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament. Recorded 11 points vs. West Virginia in the second round.

**Junior (2004-05):** Ranked second on the team in scoring (9.5 ppg) and tied for the team lead in rebounding (5.0 rpg). Started 31 of 32 games. Led the team in rebounding 11 times and paced the team in scoring five times. Scored season-high 22 points at Texas-San Antonio. Posted 14 points and a season-high 12 rebounds at Lamar.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** Ranked second on the team in scoring (13.2 ppg, 15<sup>th</sup> in the SLC) and led the team in rebounding (7.5 rpg) and blocked shots (27). Registered five double-doubles, including a 17-point, career-high 17-rebound performance vs. Troy State. Posted a career-high 29 points and added 11 rebounds at Lamar.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Averaged 10.4 points and a team-high 6.4 rebounds. Posted season highs of 26 points and 13 rebounds vs. Grambling. Recorded 16 points and ten rebounds vs. Texas-San Antonio. Tallied 14 points and 11 rebounds at Texas State.

**Personal:** Majored in biology with a pre-veterinary concentration. Nickname is "Big Smooth".
