College Highlights: Has appeared in 130 games in four years, starting 68 ... Averaging 6.0 points per contest as a Husky ... Ranks among the all-time leaders at UConn in career free throw percentage (82.2) ... UConn is 56-12 in his 68 career starts.

Senior (2008-09): Played in 35 games, started 22 games and UConn is 19-3 in those starts ... Had 17 points in the Sweet 16 win over Purdue ... Hit all ten of his free throw attempts in the NCAA West Regional ... Had ten points, five boards and three assists in the win over Syracuse on Feb. 11 Scored a career-high 21 points in the win over Hartford.

Junior (2007-08): Saw action in 31 games this season, making 16 starts ... Team was 12-4 with Austrie in the starting line-up ... Had an 89.2 free throw percentage with a 24-for-31 mark when shooting in the final two minutes ... Averaged 7.5 points and 1.9 rebounds per game ... Scored 10 points, hitting all four free throws, in NCAA First Round game against San Diego.

Sophomore (2006-07): Saw action in 30 games, making six starts ... Averaged 5.8 points per game and had 65 assists to his credit in 19.3 minutes ... Reached double-figures in scoring on eight occasions, including a season-high 14 against Syracuse.

Freshman (2005-06): Played in all 34 games, starting the first 24, and averaged 3.3 points and 2.6 assists ... Had two points, five rebounds and four assists in the Sweet 16 win over Washington ... Had seven points in 22 minutes in the win at Louisville ... Had a UConn-freshman record 14 assists in the win over Quinnipiac ... Had six points and a career-best seven assists in the win over Army ... Had a career-best 15 points in the win over Arizona, hitting all four of his shots from the field and making all six free throw attempts ... Had five points, one assist and two turnovers in 31 minutes in his first collegiate game at Pepperdine.
