College Highlights: Earned Academic All-Big 12 Second Team honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career at Texas after playing first two seasons at Cecil Community College in North East, Maryland. Sat out the 2003-04 season at Cecil as a redshirt

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 2.2 points and 1.6 rebounds in 7.4 minutes a contest. Posted career highs of ten points, three assists, and three steals vs. Alcorn State in the season opener. Tallied four points, a season-high seven rebounds, and a career-high two blocked shots vs. Nicholls State. Matched career high with three assists vs. Centenary. Posted four points and four rebounds vs. Texas-Arlington. Scored eight points on 4-for-4 shooting vs. Baylor. Registered five points and five rebounds vs. Kansas.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 1.0 points and 1.2 rebounds in 5.4 minutes a contest. Scored a season-high six points and grabbed four rebounds vs. Texas State. Tallied five points, a career-high eight rebounds, two assists, and a career-high three steals vs. Louisiana-Monroe.

Sophomore (2004-05): At Cecil CC, averaged 22.1 points, 4.9 rebounds, 2.6 assists, and 2.7 steals. Earned MVP honors at the Region XX Tournament and the Maryland JUCO Conference Tournament. Helped lead Cecil to a 31-3 record and a berth in the national tournament. Named First Team NJCAA Division II All-American.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 14.5 points, 4.9 rebounds, 1.8 assists, and 1.7 steals. Named MVP at the Dundalk Holiday Tournament.
