**Pro Career Highlights:** Spent the 2007-08 season in the CBA with the Minot Skyrockets, averaging 5.6 points and 4.6 rebounds. Ranked second in the league in field goal percentage (.617). Posted two double-doubles. Played with the Albany Patroons and Oklahoma Storm in the USBL in the summer of 2007, averaging 3.4 points and 3.0 rebounds in 18 total games. Finished the 2006-07 season in Syria with Al Jalaa Aleppo (statistics unavailable). Started the year with the Yakima Sun Kings in the CBA, averaging 7.4 points and 5.1 rebounds in seven games. Split the summer of 2006 with the Marietta Storm in the WBA and Correcaminos UAT Victoria in the Mexican LNBP. Spent the 2005-06 season in the ABA with the Mississippi Singers and Ohio Aviators (statistics unavailable). Appeared in 18 games with the Gulf Coast Bandits in the WBA in 2005, averaging 7.5 points and 6.7 rebounds. Played briefly with the Atlanta Vision in the ABA in 2004-05, averaging 8.7 points and 4.9 rebounds in seven games.

**Career Highlights:** Finished collegiate career at UTEP after playing one season each at Howard College in Big Spring, Texas and Fort Scott Community College in Kansas.

**Senior (2003-04):** Averaged 1.0 points and 0.9 rebounds in 3.0 minutes a contest. Registered season highs of ten points and five rebounds in ten minutes of playing time vs. Rice. Scored four points vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Contributed three rebounds, a blocked shot, and a steal in ten minutes of playing time vs. Boise State in the semifinals of the WAC Tournament.

**Junior (2002-03):** Averaged 3.5 points and 4.6 rebounds in 16.8 minutes a contest. Started six times. Scored in double figures three times. Recorded first career double-double with 11 points and a career-high 18 rebounds vs. Boise State. Tallied ten points and eight rebounds vs. Tulsa. Pulled down ten rebounds vs. Rice.

**Sophomore (2001-02):** At Fort Scott, averaged 14.4 points and 12.6 rebounds. Led the KJCCC and ranked ninth nationally in rebounding. Registered 23 double-doubles.

**Freshman (2000-01):** At Howard, averaged 14.2 points and 4.7 rebounds. Earned First Team All-Conference honors.

**Personal:** Majored in sociology. Teammates in high school included former Missouri standouts Keyon Dooling and Clarence Gilbert. Also participated in track in high school.
