Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA training camp with the Dallas Mavericks in the fall of 2006. An early entry candidate for the 2006 NBA Draft, but was not selected.

Career Highlights: Named Honorable Mention All-American by the Associated Press as a sophomore. Also named to the NABC All-District 7 Second Team and was a finalist for the Bob Cousy Award, which recognizes the nation's top point guard. Earned First Team All-Conference USA honors as a sophomore. Named to the Third Team as a freshman. Became the 41st player in Memphis history to score 1,000 points, finishing with 1,054 in only two seasons. Started all 73 games in which he appeared.

Sophomore (2005-06): Finished second on the team in scoring (13.4 ppg) and assists (3.1 apg). Ranked fifth in Conference USA in free throw shooting (.783). Scored 20 or more points seven times. Scored a season-high 26 points against UAB. Posted first career double-double with 22 points and a career-high 10 assists against Gonzaga. Tallied 20 points on 7-for-10 shooting at Providence. Scored 23 points and dished out six assists at Alabama. Registered 22 points and six rebounds at Tulsa. Recorded 14 points and six assists vs. Oral Roberts in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Posted 18 points on 8-for-14 shooting in the Sweet Sixteen. Contributed 13 points vs. UCLA in the Regional Finals.

Freshman (2004-05): Ranked second the team in scoring (15.4 ppg) while leading the team in assists (3.8 apg) and steals (1.7 spg). Scored 20 or more points 11 times. Registered career-high 29 points at Charlotte. Recorded 23 points and six rebounds at Texas. Tallied 25 points, five rebounds, and five assists at Louisville. Scored 16 points and dished out a season-high nine assists vs. Tulane. Shot 9-for-15 from the field in scoring 23 points vs. Louisville in the Conference USA Tournament finals. Posted 23 points and seven assists vs. Vanderbilt in the post-season NIT quarterfinals. Named to several national All-Freshman teams, including *Rivals.com*, *CollegeInsider.com*, *The Sporting News* and *Basketball Times*. Named Conference USA Freshman of the Year.

Personal: Member of National Honor Society at Edgewater High School. Father, Darius Sr., played his collegiate basketball at LeMoyn-Owen College in Memphis. Related to Chucky Atkins of the Memphis Grizzlies. In addition to basketball, his other favorite form of recreation is kickball.
