Professional Career: 2007-08: Drafted by Kansas Cagerz (USBL,3rd(24)) ... Atlas Stal Ostrow Wielkopolski (Poland-DBE), only pre-season ... signed with Gothia Basket (Sweden-Baskettigan, starting five): 32 games: 15,9 ppg, 9.3rpg, 1.7apg, 1.3spg ... 2008-09: Dnipro Dnepropetrovsk (Ukraine-Superleague, starting five): 48 games: 13.9 ppg, 5.8 rpg, 1.2 apg, 1.2 spg.

Senior (2006-07): Played in 30 games his senior season, missing two December games recovering from a sprained ankle ... Started 25 contests, averaging 24 minutes per game ... Averaged 7.4 points per game and 4.5 rebounds per game ... Made 90-of-162 field goal attempts or 55.6 percent Had 11 blocks, including a career high three against Ole Miss in the season finale (3/9/07) ... Had career high in points of 22 at Ole Miss in regular season game (2/14/07) ... In that game made 10-of-14 field goal attempts ... Finished his college career with three straight double figure scoring games -- 12 vs. South Carolina (3/3/07), 12 vs. Tennessee (SECT, 3/8/07) and 13 vs. Ole Miss (SECT, 3/9/07) ... Had nine games in double figures ... Finished his career, appearing in 120 games with 48 starts ... Tigers won 82 games in his four years ... Made 237-of-446 field goals (53.1 percent) and 120-of-188 free throws (63.8 percent) ... grabbed 356 rebounds (3.0 career average) and 595 points (5.0 career average).

Junior (2005-06): Played in all 36 games, with 15 starts, the first starts since his freshman season ... Started the first nine games of the season, final two games of the regular season, two in the SEC Tournament and the first two rounds of the NCAA Tournament ... The last starts were in place of Tyrus Thomas who was recovering from a sprained ankle ... Posted 11 games in double figures, giving him 14 for his career ... Had career high of 20 vs. UNO (12/13), hitting 8-of-14 field goals with two blocks in 27 minutes ... Also scored 16 in the SEC Tournament win vs. Vanderbilt (3/10) ... Had 10 points and seven boards in first round NCAA win over Iona (3/15) and came off the bench to score 10 points with two assists in first half of win over No. 1 Duke (3/23) in the NCAAs when Glen Davis and Tyrus Thomas were in early foul trouble ... For the season, averaged 6.7 points, 3.4 rebounds and 18.9 minutes a contest.

Sophomore (2004-05): Appeared in 25 games, averaged 6.9 minutes per game ... Hit 20-of-34 field goal attempts and averaged 2.0 points and 1.2 rebounds a game ... Had a high of nine points twice during the season -- vs. the University of New Orleans (11/24), hit all three field goal and free throw attempts, and vs. Auburn on Feb. 9 when he made four-of-five field goal attempts ... Scored seven points in season opener vs. Tulane (11/19) ... Played double-figure minutes on seven occasions during the year ... Season high of seven rebounds vs. UNO (11/24).

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged just over 12 minutes a contest for the season, played in all 29 games, started eight, including the last five of the season ... Started opener versus Southern (11/21), played 36 minutes, hit all five field goal attempts and scored 13 points ... Also had double figures off the bench against Auburn (2/18) with points and 11 at Auburn (3/6) ... In the two games against Auburn, he was 10-of-14 from the field ... Had nine rebounds in the Tournament game against South Carolina (3/12) ... Last five games when starting averaged over 20 minutes of playing time ... 36-of-64 (56.3 percent) from the field, averaging 2.9 points per game and 2.4 rebounds.
