Pro Career Highlights: Played with six teams in the NBA from 1996-97 to 2004-05. Participated in NBA training camp with the Dallas Mavericks in the fall of 2007. Participated in NBA training camp with the New Jersey Nets in the fall of 2006. Played with Maratonistas de Coamo in Puerto Rico in the summer of 2006, averaging 11.3 points and 5.0 rebounds in three games. Spent the 2005-06 season with Talk N Text Phone Pals in the Philippines (statistics unavailable). Spent the 2004-05 season in the NBA with the Detroit Pistons, averaging 1.8 points and 1.7 rebounds. With the Pistons in 2003-04, averaged 1.8 points and 1.7 rebounds in 54 games. With the Atlanta Hawks in 2002-03, averaged 2.4 points and 2.0 rebounds in 75 games. With the Milwaukee Bucks in 2001-02, averaged 4.3 points and 2.9 rebounds in 70 games. With the Bucks in 2000-01, averaged 3.8 points and 4.2 rebounds in 29 games. With the Bucks in 1999-00, averaged 5.1 points and 4.9 rebounds in 35 games. Spent the 1998-99 season in Spain with Granada, averaging 11.7 points and 7.0 rebounds in 12 games. With the Washington Bullets in the NBA in 1997-98, averaged 2.0 points and 1.8 rebounds in 71 games. Split his rookie season in the NBA with the Denver Nuggets and Indiana Pacers, averaging 2.3 points and 1.6 rebounds in 36 total games. Played in the USBL in the summer of 2006 with the Jacksonville Barracudas and the Florida Sharks, averaging 7.2 points and 5.0 rebounds in 24 total games.

College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Southwest Conference honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career at Texas Tech after playing one season and redshirting another at Otero Junior College in La Junta, Colorado. As a senior, averaged 9.1 points and 5.7 rebounds in 23.4 minutes a contest. As a junior, averaged 6.9 points and 4.3 rebounds in 21.3 minutes a contest. As a redshirt sophomore, averaged 8.2 points and 5.4 rebounds in 23.9 minutes a contest. As a sophomore at Otero JC, only appeared in one game before redshirting the remainder of the season due to injury. As a freshman at Otero JC, averaged 14 points and nine rebounds, shooting 58 percent from the field and 78 percent from the free throw line.

Personal: Played just one year of high school basketball. Has also done work as an NBA studio analyst for Fox Sports Southwest. Father, Wilmer Jones Ham, served as mayor of Saginaw from 2001-05.
