Pro Career Highlights: Spent the summer of 2008 in Venezuela with Marinos de Anzoategui, averaging 4.3 points and 2.3 assists in three games. Finished the 2007-08 season in the NBA Developmental League with the Austin Toros and Albuquerque Thunderbirds, averaging 7.2 points and 2.7 assists in 18 total games. Started the year in the Mexico LNBP with Mayas de Yucatan Merida, averaging a league-high 26.6 points. Selected by the Toros in the seven round (96th pick overall) of the 2007 NBA D-League Draft. Played with the Anaheim Arsenal in the NBA D-League in 2006-07, averaging 12.5 points and 5.3 assists. Selected by the Arsenal in the sixth round (72nd pick overall) of the 2006 NBA D-League Draft. Spent the summer of 2006 with the Marietta Storm in the WBA, leading the league in scoring (32.9 ppg) and assists (11.4 apg), before moving on to the Mexico LNBP with Mayas de Yucatan, leading the league in scoring (35.4 ppg) and assists (11.2 apg). Played briefly in the NBA D-League in 2005-06 with the Fort Worth Flyers, averaging 5.9 points and 1.0 assists in seven games. Averaged 20.8 points and 6.9 assists in 12 games with the Las Vegas Rattlers in the ABA in 2004-05, earning ABA Rookie of the Year honors. Moved on to play with the Rome Gladiators in the WBA, averaging 23.1 points (ranking third) and a league-leading 10.1 assists. Helped Rome capture the 2005 WBA title and was named league MVP.

College Career Highlights: Spent two seasons at Brevard Community College in Florida. Tried to enroll at Southern Indiana in September of 2004, and was practicing with the team, before deciding to sign a professional contract with the Las Vegas Rattlers of the American Basketball Association.

Sophomore (2002-03): At Brevard CC, ranked second nationally in scoring (28.5 ppg) and eighth in assists (8.3 apg). Named All-Region, All-State and All-Conference and earned FCCAA MVP honors.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 21.5 points, 8.4 assists and 3.7 steals. Ranked second in the league in assists and steals and fifth in scoring. Named All-State, All-Region and All-Conference.
