Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2007-08 season in the German 2.Bundesliga with the Duesseldorf Magics, averaging 10.9 points and a league-leading 11.4 rebounds in 18 games. Played with Znicz Sokolow Jaroslaw in Poland and ENAD in Cyprus in 2006-07 (statistics unavailable).

College Highlights: Earned Third Team All-Southern Conference honors as a junior. Finished collegiate career as the 23rd all-time leading scorer in Western Carolina history with 1,180 points. Started 79 of 111 career games.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 11.4 points and 6.3 rebounds. Started 27 of 29 games. Scored in double figures 18 times. Registered season-high 28 points vs. Gardner-Webb. Posted five double-doubles, including a 11-point, season-high 14 rebound effort at Appalachian State. Recorded 17 points and 12 rebounds at Wofford. Scored 23 points and grabbed seven rebounds at UNC Greensboro. Tallied ten points and 12 rebounds vs. UNC Greensboro in the first round of the Southern Conference Tournament.

Junior (2004-05): Led team in scoring (14.6 ppg, sixth in the SoCon) and rebounding (8.0 rpg, fifth). Started 27 of 29 games. Posted eight double-doubles. Recorded season-high 26 points, eight rebounds, and three assists at Furman. Notched 23 points and seven rebounds at Alabama. Registered 24 points, 11 rebounds, and a season-high four assists vs. Appalachian State. Scored 20 points at Marquette. Posted 18 points and 11 rebounds at Iowa. Tallied 16 points and 14 rebounds vs. UNC Greensboro .

Sophomore (2003-04): Led the team in rebounding (7.6 rpg, fourth in the SoCon) and ranked second in scoring (12.4 ppg). Started 20 of 27 games. Registered eight double-doubles. Posted a career-high 29 points and added 14 rebounds vs. College of Charleston. Recorded 24 points and 14 rebounds vs. UNC Greensboro. Scored 16 points and pulled down a season-high 15 rebounds vs. North Greenville. Tallied 12 points and 12 rebounds vs. Furman in the first round of the Southern Conference Tournament.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 3.5 points and 2.7 rebounds in 12.9 minutes a contest. Started five times. Posted season highs of 19 points, 16 rebounds, and two assists vs. Toccoa Falls. Scored seven points and grabbed eight rebounds in his collegiate debut vs. Coastal Carolina. Grabbed eight rebounds at Appalachian State.
