Scored 22 points at Western Illinois. Recorded 25 points and five rebounds at UMKC. Registered 14 points vs. Washington State. Notched 18 points in the season opener at BYU. Scored 15 points and grabbed a season-high seven rebounds vs. Chicago State. Posted 20 points at Oral Roberts. Scored 19 points vs. IUPUI in the first round of the Mid-Continent Tournament.

**Junior (2002-03):** Averaged 11.7 points and 4.5 rebounds. Started 26 of 28 games. Scored in double figures 16 times. Posted 22 points and five rebounds vs. UMKC. Tallied 18 points and eight rebounds at Washington State. Recorded 19 points vs. Oral Roberts. Pulled down a season-high 11 rebounds vs. Oakland. Led team with 18 points vs. Oakland in the first round of the Mid-Continent Tournament. Scored a season-high 26 points vs. IUPUI in the semifinals.

**Sophomore (2001-02):** Averaged 19.1 points, 9.5 rebounds, and 3.5 assists. Earned Bay Valley Conference MVP and All-State honors.
