College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career at Florida Atlantic after playing first two seasons at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Senior (2006-07): Led team in scoring (20.5 ppg). Set a school single season record for three-point field goal percentage (.479). Started 20 of 21 games, missing the first semester due to academic ineligibility. Scored 20 or more points ten times. Tied a school record with a career-high 39 points, including 10-for-16 shooting from three-point range at Troy. Recorded 32 points at Arkansas State. Scored 18 points and dished out a career-high six assists at New Orleans. Sank 7-for-8 from beyond the three-point line in scoring 29 points vs. Florida International. Posted 30 points and a career-high seven rebounds vs. Western Kentucky in the first round of the Sun Belt Tournament.

Junior (2005-06): Led team in scoring (16.1 ppg, ranked seventh in the Atlantic Sun). Started 18 of 27 games. Led team in scoring 14 times. Scored 20 or more points nine times, including one stretch of five straight games. Recorded season highs of 29 points and five steals vs. Jacksonville. Scored 23 points in three straight contests vs. Marist, at Kennesaw State, and at East Tennessee State. Tallied 17 points and a season-high six rebounds vs. Lipscomb.

Sophomore (2004-05): At Frank Phillips, averaged 22.1 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 2.9 assists. Led the WJCAC in scoring and ranked fourth in free throw percentage (.803). Earned league co-MVP honors, was named First Team All-Region V, and earned Honorable Mention All-American honors.

Freshman (2003-04): Averaged 17.3 points, 5.0 rebounds, and 2.3 assists. Ranked third in the WJCAC in scoring and led the league in free throw percentage (.880). Scored season-high 29 points at Odessa.
