College Highlights: Played in 125 games with Oklahoma and Charlotte and averaged 9.0 points, 5.4 rebounds and 1.5 assists.

Senior (2006-07): The 49ers leading scorer (17.9 ppg) was a first team all-Atlantic 10 selection ... played in 30 games and averaged 17.6 points, 7.1 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game.

Junior (2005-06): The 49ers leading scorer (17.0 ppg) was a first team all-Atlantic 10 choice who led the league in three-pointers made (96) ... had three games with 30+ points, including 32-point effort in regular-season finale .. ranked third in the A-10 in three-point accuracy (.429), which improved to .462 in league games ... scored in double-figures a team-high 28 games with 12 20-point games ... second on the team with 6.1 rebounds per game, including 2.75 offensive rebounds ... second on the team with 35 steals ... sat out the 2004-05 as a transfer from Oklahoma.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 9.6 points and 4.8 rebounds as a sophomore ... started 19 of 31 games played ... shot .440 from the field and .374 from three-point range... MVP of the Sooner Invitational, averaging 17.5 points in wins over Eastern Washington and Oral Roberts ... career-high 22 points in win over Princeton to be named all-College MVP.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 7.1 points and 3.6 rebounds as a freshman ... was named to the Big 12 all-Reserve Team ... shot .390 from the floor and .358 from three-point range ... averaged a team-best 11.8 points with 4.5 rebounds and a .571 3FG% in Sooners' 2003 NCAA Tournament run to the Elite Eight.
