Pro Career Highlights: Played with the Cuxhaven BasCats in the German 2.Bundesliga in 2006-07, averaging 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 4.1 assists in 23 games. Ranked second on the team in scoring, assists, and three-point field goals made.

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career at Southern Cal after playing first two seasons at Allegany College in Cumberland, Maryland. Started four career games at USC.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 3.9 points and 1.6 assists in 13.1 minutes a contest. Started twice. Scored in double figures four times. Registered career-high 15 points, hitting 4-for-5 from three-point range, at Washington. Tallied 12 points and a career-high five rebounds at UCLA. Scored 12 points in the rematch. Dished out a season-high five assists at Washington State.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 5.2 points and 1.9 assists in 16.0 minutes a contest. Had arthroscopic surgery to correct a meiscus tear in his knee and missed 13 games as a result. Started twice in 16 total appearances. Scored in double figures four times. Registered season-high 12 pions vs. UC Irvine in the season opener. Scored ten points vs. Arizona State. Tallied 11 points in games at Stanford and vs. Oregon. Dished out a career-high seven assists at California.

Sophomore (2003-04): At Allegany, averaged 21.4 points, 3.6 rebounds, 5.5 assists, and 2.0 steals. Hit a school-record 114 three-pointers. Posted a season-high 40 points vs. Lon Morris in the NJCAA Tournament. Sank ten threes vs. College of Southern Idaho. Earned All-Conference, All-Region, and NJCAA All-American honors.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 11.9 points, 4.5 assists, and 1.7 steals. Had four 20-point games, registering a season-high of 27 points.
