Pro Career Highlights: Played with Lobos De La UAC Saltillo in the Mexican LNBP in 2007. An early entry candidate for the 2007 NBA Draft, but was not selected.

College Highlights: Played one season at Liberty after starting collegiate career at Providence. Left Providence in the fall of 2005 due to personal reasons and enrolled at Liberty the following spring.

Junior (2006-07): Averaged 14.7 points and 4.7 rebounds in 25.2 minutes a contest. Played in 25 games, starting eight times, after becoming eligible to play after the first semester. Scored 20 or more points four times. Registered a career-high 30 points on 12-for-14 shooting and pulled down seven rebounds vs. VMI. Tallied 26 points, eight rebounds, and a season-high seven assists in the rematch. Posted 28 points and seven rebounds vs. High Point. Registered only double-double of the season with 17 points and ten rebounds vs. Lipscomb. Scored 20 points vs. Seton Hall. Recorded 15 points vs. VMI in the first round of the Big South Tournament.

Sophomore (2004-05): At Providence, averaged 13.3 points and 4.3 rebounds. Started 22 of 23 games, missing eight contests due to a sprained ankle. Set career high with 23 points vs. Wake Forest. Matched career high with 23 points and added seven rebounds, six assists, three blocked shots, and four steals vs. Michigan on his way to Pre-Season NIT All-Tournament Team honors. Registered first career double-double with 21 points and ten rebounds vs. Pennsylvania. Scored 21 points and grabbed eight rebounds vs. Syracuse. Tallied 17 points and seven assists vs. Virginia.

Freshman (2004-05): Averaged 5.7 points and 2.5 rebounds in 19.8 minutes a contest. Started six times. Posted season-high 17 points vs. Siena. Scored 12 points vs. Georgetown. Tallied ten points and five rebounds vs. Syracuse. Posted ten points, four rebounds, four assists, and four steals at Boston College. Pulled down a season-high six rebounds at St. John's. Registered 11 points and three steals vs. Pittsburgh.
