Pro Career Highlights: Played with four teams in the NBA from 2000-01 to 2005-06. Participated in NBA training camp with the New Jersey Nets in the fall of 2007. Spent the 2006-07 season in Russia with Dynamo Moscow, averaging 7.3 points and 2.5 assists in 33 Russian League games and 6.2 points and 1.4 assists in 20 Euroleague games. Played in the NBA with the Indiana Pacers in 2005-06, averaging 1.1 points in 41 games. With the Pacers in 2004-05, averaged 3.7 points and 1.1 assists in 73 games. Started the 2003-04 season in Greece with Ionikos, averaging 15.8 points and 3.7 assists in six games. Came back home to the United States and joined the Dakota Wizards for 25 games, averaging 18.1 points and 8.0 assists. Finished the year with the Portland Trail Blazers,

averaging 2.3 points in 22 games. Started the 2002-03 season with the Asheville Attitude in the NBA Developmental League, averaging 12.5 points and 5.2 assists in 35 games. Finished the year with Reggio Emilia in the Italian Legadue, averaging 14.1 points and 2.9 rebounds in 13 games. Started the 2001-02 season with the Kansas City Knights in the ABA, averaging 12.1 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 6.7 assists in 18 games. Finished the year with the Memphis Grizzlies in the NBA, averaging 5.0 points and 2.1 assists in 23 games. Split the 2000-01 season in the NBA, IBL, ABA, and Italy. Started the year with the Las Vegas Silver Bandits in the IBL, averaged 14.1 points, 4.2 rebounds, and 6.9 assists in 31 games. Moved on to the Kansas City Knights in the ABA, averaging 6.0 points and 9.0 assists in two games. Signed two 10-day contracts with the New Jersey Nets in the NBA, appearing in eight games and averaging 4.9 points and 3.0 assists. Finished the year in Italy joining Fortitudo Bologna in time for the post-season, averaging 10.9 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 2.9 assists in ten total games.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-Big Sky honors his junior and senior seasons. Finished collegiate career at Weber State after playing one season each at the College of Eastern Utah and Salt Lake Community College. As a senior, averaged 16.3 points, 6.4 rebounds, and 6.9 assists. As a junior, averaged 14.0 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 4.5 assists. As a sophomore at Salt Lake CC, averaged 16.4 points, 4.2 rebounds, and 6.4 assists. As a freshman at Eastern Utah, averaged 6.1 points and 2.4 assists.

Personal: Married with two children. Enjoys spending time with his family during his spare time. While playing with the New Jersey Nets, was credited with scoring the eight millionth point in NBA history during a game against the Boston Celtics on April 15, 2001.
