Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2006-07 season in the NBA Developmental League with the Idaho Stampede, averaging 15.6 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 2.3 assists in 27 games. Selected by the Stampede in the 2nd round (16th pick overall) of the 2006 NBA D-League Draft. Participated in NBA summer league with the New Orleans Hornets in 2005. Played five seasons in the NBA with the Charlotte Hornets and the Chicago Bulls. In 2003-04 with the Bulls, averaged 6.7 points and 2.0 rebounds in 51 games. In 2002-03 with the Bulls, averaged 5.7 points and 3.1 rebounds in 64 games. In 2001-02 with the Bulls, averaged 9.0 points and 2.7 rebounds in 29 games. In 2001-02 with the Hornets, averaged 7.4 points and 3.0 rebounds in 67 games. As a rookie with the Hornets in 2001-02, averaged 7.0 points and 2.7 rebounds in 67 games. Started 48 of 278 career games played, averaging 19.2 minutes a contest. Scored career-high 21 points vs. Los Angeles Clippers in 2001-02. Grabbed a career-high ten rebounds vs. Atlanta in 2000-01. An early entry candidate for the 1997 NBA draft, but was not selected.

College Highlights: Earned Consensus Division II First Team All-American honors as a senior. Named Lone Star Conference North Division Player of the Year. Ranks as Central Oklahoma's 23rd all-time leading scorer with 1,129 career points. Finished collegiate career at Central Oklahoma after starting career at Trinity Valley Community College in Athens, Texas and routing through Brown Mackie College in Salina, Kansas. Did not play competitive basketball during the 1995-96 season.

Senior (1998-99): Led Division II in scoring (28.0 ppg). Started all 26 games. Scored 30 or more points nine times and topped the 40-point mark five times. Recorded 13 double-doubles. Exploded for a career-high and school-record setting 52 points on 19-for-27 shooting vs. Southwestern Oklahoma. Registered 21 points and a career-high 15 rebounds vs. East Central. Recorded 41 points and 11 rebounds at Southwestern Oklahoma. Posted 41 points and 14 rebounds at Montana State-Billings.

Junior (1997-98): Averaged 14.8 points and 7.4 rebounds. Started 14 of 27 games. Scored 20 or more points eight times. Posted eight double-doubles. Registered season-high 24 points twice, vs. Southern Connecticut State, and at Cameron. Tallied 22 points and 11 rebounds vs. Seattle Pacific. Scored 15 points and grabbed a career-high 16 rebounds vs. Abilene Christian.

Sophomore (1996-97): Led team in scoring (22.7 ppg) and three-point field goals made (101). Posted season-high 41 points vs. Colby CC. Tallied 39 points vs. Northeastern (Colo.) JC.

Freshman (1994-95): Played at Trinity Valley CC (statistics unavailable).
