Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA summer league with the New Orleans Hornets in the summer of 2007. Played in Turkey with Mersin Buyuksehir Belediyesi in 2006-07, averaging 9.6 points and 2.9 rebounds in eight games. Participated in NBA summer league with the Hornets in the summer of 2006. Spent the 2005-06 season in the NBA Developmental League with the Austin Toros, averaging 12.5 points and 3.8 rebounds in 42 games. Selected by the Toros in the second round (16th pick overall) of the 2005 NBA D-League Draft. Participated in NBA summer league with the Seattle SuperSonics in the summer of 2005. Played with the Great Lakes Storm in the CBA in 2004-05, averaging 20.9 points and 5.9 rebounds in 28 games. Earned Second Team All-CBA honors. Appeared in one game with the Southern Crescent Lightning in the WBA in the summer of 2004, scoring four points. Played with the Columbus Riverdragons in the NBA D-League in 2003-04, averaging 11.4 points and 3.0 rebounds in 11 games.

Career Highlights: Earned Second Team All-SEC honors his junior and senior seasons. Finished college career as the 14th all-time leading scorer in school history, with 1349 points. Also ranks second all-time in school history in three-point shots made and attempted. Started 88 of the 90 games he appeared in. Sat out his freshman season at Georgia while establishing academic eligibility.

Senior (2002-03): As a senior, averaged 16.6 points and 5.0 rebounds. Ranked fifth in the conference in scoring and three-point field goal percentage, and first in three-point field goals made. Led team in scoring 13 times. Tossed in 29 points (25 in the second half) and grabbed eight boards against Tennessee. Recorded 23 points and eight rebounds at California. Registered 25 points, shooting a perfect 7-for-7 from behind the three-point arc against LSU. Led team with 20 points and nine rebounds against Texas.

Junior (2001-02): As a junior, averaged 16.5 points and 5.4 rebounds. Set single-season school record for three-point field goals made with 93. Scored 20 or more points in 11 games. Sank six three-pointers on his way to 26 points against Colorado. Posted double-double of 20 points and 11 rebounds against Georgetown. Grabbed career-high 12 rebounds against Samford. Tallied 26 points in season opener against Furman. Recorded season-high 27 points against LSU in the SEC Tournament.

Sophomore (2000-01): As a sophomore, averaged 12.0 points and 4.2 rebounds. Recorded career-high of 30 points, including eight points in overtime, against Auburn. Registered 25 points on 10-for-12 shooting against Mississippi State. Tallied 24 points and six rebounds at Florida. Scored 23 points on 9-for-14 shooting in collegiate debut against Georgia State.
