Professional Career: 2008-09: Matrixx Magix Nijmegen (Holland-Eredivisie, starting five), injured in December: 28 games: 12.9 ppg, 2.8 rpg, 1.8 apg, 1.7spg.

College Highlights: Played in 120 games starting 87 ... averaged 10.4 points, 4.15 rebounds and 1.5 assists in 25.8 minutes per game ... finished his college career shooting .442 percent from the field, .690 from the foul line and .345 from three-point range.

Senior (2007-08): Averaged a career high 13.4 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.2 assists in 30.3 minutes per game ... played in all 30 games starting 29 ... shot .428 percent from the field, .314 percent from three-point range and .761 percent from the foul line ... recorded a career high 32 points against Vanderbilt ...

Junior (2006-07): Averaged 11.8 points, 4.8 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.3 steals in 28.2 minutes per game ... played in all 32 games, starting 28 ... shot 48 percent from the field, 38 percent from three-point range and 72 percent from the foul line ... ranked 10th in the SEC in free throw percent ... notched his first career double-double with 18 points and 10 rebounds vs. Arkansas Feb. 21 ... at the team's annual awards banquet, received the Lambert/Eagles Award, the highest award an Auburn basketball player can receive.

Sophomore (2005-06): Averaged 9.1 points, 3.5 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 1.3 assists in 23.4 minutes per game ... played in all 28 games, starting 19 ... shot 43 percent from the field, 36 percent from 3-point range and 58 percent from the foul line ... scored a season-high 21 points and had 5 rebounds and 4 steals at eventual National Champion Florida... received the team's Sixth-Man Award for the second consecutive year at the season ending awards banquet

Freshman (2004-05): Averaged 6.9 points and 3.0 rebounds in 21.2 minutes per game ... played in 30 games, starting 11 ... shot 42 percent from the field, 33 percent from 3-point range and 65 percent from the foul line ... named SEC player of the week after totaling 29 points (10-of-14 fgs, 4-of-7 3fgs), 6 rebounds and 3 assists in a season-high 39 minutes vs. Mississippi State Feb. 5 ... presented the Sixth-Man Award at the team's banquet.
