College Highlights: Sat out the entire 2004-05 season with an Achilles tendon injury. Had also missed the majority of the 2002-03 season, prompting the NCAA to grant him a sixth year of eligibility on August 23, 2005. Scored in double figures 18 times.

Senior (2006-07): Averaged 2.4 points and 1.4 rebounds in 12.5 minutes a contest. Started five times. Recorded season-high nine points at Wyoming. Tallied six points at Air Force. Made all six free throw attempts in scoring six points vs. Wyoming. Grabbed a season-high six rebounds in the season opener vs. Southern Colorado. Registered a season-high three assists at TCU.

Junior (2005-06): Averaged 5.7 points and 2.4 rebounds in 16.8 minutes a contest. Started 15 of 25 games, missing six games due to injury. Scored in double figures six times. Led team in scoring three times. Registered season-high 18 points on 6-for-8 shooting at Wyoming. Tallied 16 points and four assists vs. TCU. Hit all six field goal attempts in scoring 15 points in 13 minutes vs. New Mexico. Pulled down a season-high eight rebounds vs. San Diego State. Scored 16 points vs. TCU in the first round of the Mountain West Tournament.

Redshirt Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 8.9 points and 3.0 rebounds in 23.3 minutes a contest. Started 22 of 27 games, missing two contests due to a hamstring injury. Scored in double figures 11 times. Exploded for a career-high 31 points and grabbed a season-high eight rebounds at UNLV. Scored 19 points vs. New Mexico. Tallied 16 points, five rebounds, and four assists vs. Colorado. Recorded 16 points and five rebounds at BYU.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 1.3 points and 1.5 rebounds in 7.5 minutes a contest. Only played in six games due to a back injury and was granted a medical redshirt. Scored four points and grabbed four rebounds vs. Texas A&M-Kingsville. Tallied four points at Arkansas-Little Rock.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 3.3 points and 1.7 rebounds in 14.1 minutes a contest. Missed six games due to a left medial collateral knee ligament injury. Started two times. Registered season-high 12 points vs. Hawaii. Pulled down a season-high seven rebounds at Wyoming.
