Senior (2008-09): Named First Team All-Patriot League ... named Patriot League Tournament MVP ... named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches All-District 13 First Team ... became the 27th player in AU history to surpass 1,000 career points, finished his career with 1,412 ... American University and Patriot League's all-time leader in three-pointers with 302 ... named Patriot League Player of the Week four times ... appeared in 32 games, starting 31 ... led team with 17.9 ppg and added 3.1 rpg ... ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in the NCAA in 3-pointers per game (3.6), 44<sup>th</sup> in 3-point percentage (38.9) and 70<sup>th</sup> in ppg (17.9) ... led the team in scoring in 17 games.

Junior (2007-08): All-Patriot League First Team honoree ... started 32 of 33 games ... played all 40 minutes in 11 games, including all PL Tournament games ... averaged 18.4 points per game, ranking him third in the conference ... scored double-digits in 30 of 33 games ... led the league in free throw percentage (89.2 percent), 3-point FG percentage (45.2 percent), and 3-point FG made (135) ... his 135 made treys set a new PL and AU single season record ... has 188 career 3-point field goals, ranking him third all-time ... scored a career-high 32 points at Lafayette (2/2/08) on 10-of-16 shooting, including six threes ... recorded a career-high seven three-pointers at Dayton (12/19) ... was a career-best 8-of-8 from the free throw line against Colgate (1/19) and in the PL semifinal against Army (3/9) ... grabbed a career-high eight rebounds against Howard (12/4) and Lehigh (2/10) ... tied his career-high of four assists at St. Francis (11/10) and in the PL semifinal against Army (3/9) ... grabbed a career-high three steals at Army (1/23) ... named Patriot League Anaconda Player of the Week three times, all during the conference portion of the schedule ... named POTW (1/14) after scoring 24 points, including 6-of-8 from behind the arc at Lehigh ... named POTW (2/11) after averaging 22.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg, and 2.5 apg ... named POTW (2/18) after averaging 24.0 ppg., 3.5 rpg., and 1.5 steals per game.

Sophomore (2006-07): Played in 26 games ... hit 22 three-pointers, third-most on the squad ... 22 of 32 field goals were from outside the arc ... missed only two free throws all season (12-14) ... tallied a season-high 15 points in a win over Morgan State (11/14) ... hit 5-of-7 treys in that game ... had 14 points against Bucknell (1/9) while playing a season-high 29 minutes ... had two steals in four games, versus Yale (12/9), Maryland (12/23), Lehigh (1/6) and Bucknell (1/9) ... named to Patriot League Academic Honor Roll.

Freshman (2005-06): Played in 28 games for the Eagles ... tallied in double-digits four times ... finished the season as the Eagles' top three-point threat, hitting 31 treys at a .419 clip ... set a career-high in leading the Eagles to a win over Towson with 25 points, hitting 8-of-13 shots and 6-of-10 three-point attempts (12/10) ... tallied his first career double-digit point game with 13 points at La Salle, hitting 5-of-6 shots (11/26) ... hit 4-of-8 treys, finishing with 14 points in just 17 minutes of action, in a win at St. Francis (Pa.) (1/2) ... tallied 13 points with three three-pointers in a win versus Lafayette (1/28).
