**Professional Highlights:** Drafted by the Sioux Falls Skyforce in the 4<sup>th</sup> round of the 2008 NBA D-League Draft. Appeared in 18 games for the Skyforce being being traded to the Tulsa 66ers where he played an additional 25 games. Scored in double figures 15 times during the season, including a career-high 23 points on April 11 in a road victory over the Albuquerque Thunderbirds. Previous career high was 20 points, scored on Jan. 10 against the Dakota Wizards.

**College Highlights:** Ranks as the eighth all-time leader in assists in Arkansas history with 303. Finished collegiate career at Arkansas after playing first two seasons at Mississippi State. Sat out the 2005-06 season at Arkansas under NCAA transfer rules. Recorded four-year career totals of 1,093 points, 537 assists, and 150 steals.

**Senior (2007-08):** Averaged 9.5 points, 2.6 rebounds, and 3.8 assists (ranked ninth in the SEC). Started 14 of 35 games. Scored in double figures 15 times. Recorded 17 points vs. Texas-San Antonio. Tallied 13 points, four rebounds, and a season-high seven assists vs. Vanderbilt. Posted 15 points and six assists vs. Florida. Set season-high of 18 points vs. Vanderbilt in the first round of the SEC Tournament. Dished out a season-high-tying seven assists vs. Indiana in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Junior (2006-07):** Averaged 9.9 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 4.8 assists (fifth in the SEC). Started 29 of 35 games. Scored in double figures 15 times. Recorded career-high 21 points at Vanderbilt. Tallied 20 points, six rebounds, and seven assists vs. Mississippi State. Registered a double-double of 18 points and a season-high 11 assists vs. Alabama. Scored 11 points and dished out nine assists at Florida.

**Sophomore (2004-05):** At Mississippi State, averaged 7.4 points, 2.4 rebounds, and 4.7 assists (third in the SEC). Scored in double figures ten times. Posted two double-doubles. Recorded a season-high 15 points and eight assists at Xavier. Tallied a season-high-matching 15 points and 11 assists vs. Ole Miss. Registered 11 points and ten assists vs. Jackson State. Dished out a career-high 14 assists vs. Florida A&M.

**Freshman (2003-04):** Averaged 5.4 points, 1.1 rebounds, and 2.5 assists. Scored in double figures four times. Led team with a season-high 13 points at LSU. Dished out a season-high six assists vs. UAB. Tallied nine points and five assists vs. Xavier in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Earned SEC All-Freshman Team honors.
