Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2005-06 season in Belgium with Liege, averaging 5.1 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 1.2 blocked shots in 14 games. Also appeared in one game for Brest in the French League, scoring six points and grabbing four rebounds. Played with the Westchester Wildfire in the USBL in the summer of 2005, averaging 14.2 points, 10.1 rebounds, and 3.1 blocked shots. Ranked second in the league in both rebounds and blocked shots. Named to the All-Rookie Team.

College Highlights: Named Pennsylvania Athletic Conference Player of the Year his junior and senior seasons. Earned First Team All-Conference all four seasons. Earned Third Team Division III All-American honors as a senior and earned honorable mention as a junior.

Senior (2004-05): Ranked in the national top ten in rebounds (12.3 rpg, fifth), blocked shots (3.0 bpg, fourth), and field goal percentage (.636, eighth), while leading the PAC in scoring (19.6 ppg). Started all 27 games. Posted 20 double-doubles. Exploded for a career-high 38 points at Neumann. Recorded 29 points and 15 rebounds at Wesley College and registered 29 points and 13 rebounds in the rematch. Scored 30 points at Franklin & Marshall. Notched a double-double of 21 points and a career-high 21 rebounds vs. Eastern University. Tallied 28 points and nine rebounds in the season opener at Rowan. Blocked a season-high seven shots at Alvernia.

Junior (2003-04): Ranked sixth nationally in rebounding (12.1 rpg), third in blocked shots (4.5 bpg), and 11th in field goal percentage (.607) while averaging 21.4 ppg.

Sophomore (2002-03): Ranked 12th nationally in rebounding (11.0 rpg) and ninth in blocked shots (3.1 bpg). Ranked third in the PAC in scoring (20.4 ppg), second in field goal percentage (.588),

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 16.1 points, 8.6 rebounds, and 2.2 blocked shots. Earned PAC Rookie of Year honors.
