Pro Career Highlights: Spent the 2005-06 season with the Itzehoe Eagles in Germany's 2. Regionalliga North League. Averaged a league-leading 27.4 points in 21 games. Posted a season-high of 51 points.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-PSAC West honors as a senior and earned Second Team honors as a junior. Finished collegiate career at Indiana University of Pennsylvania after starting at Alaska-Anchorage and routing through the College of Eastern Utah in Price, Utah.

Senior (2004-05): Ranked second on the team in scoring (14.7 ppg, ninth in the PSAC) and rebounding (6.6 rpg, 13th). Recorded six double-doubles. Scored 20 or more points seven times. Matched career-high with 29 points and added ten rebounds at Shippensburg. Registered 28 points and 12 rebounds vs. East Stroudsburg. Posted 23 points and 11 rebounds at Kutztown. Scored 25 points vs. Slippery Rock. Led team with 23 points and ten rebounds in an overtime win at Pitt-Johnstown.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 12.0 points and 7.4 rebounds. Started 17 of 21 games, missing several games due to a concussion, broken nose, and ankle injury. Grabbed ten or more rebounds seven times and registered six double-doubles. Set career-highs with 29 points (on 14-for-19 shooting) and 17 rebounds vs. District of Columbia in the regular season finale. Scored 23 points at Pitt-Johnstown. Recorded double-doubles in three straight road games at Lock Haven, Clarion, and Edinboro. Scored 21 points and grabbed 16 rebounds on his way to PSAC Tournament MVP honors.

Sophomore (2002-03): At Eastern Utah, averaged 8.1 points and 5.1 rebounds. Ranked second on the team in three-point field goals made (32). Scored a season-high 19 points and grabbed nine rebounds vs. Hill Air Force Base. Matched season-high with 19 points on 8-for-11 shooting at Glendale (Ariz.) CC. Pulled down a season-high 15 rebounds at Scottsdale (Ariz.) CC.

Freshman (2001-02): At Alaska-Anchorage, averaged 7.2 points and 4.6 rebounds in 16.8 minutes a contest. Ranked first in rebounding among all freshmen in the Great Northwest Athletic Conference. Started 18 times. Registered a season-high 29 points on 10-for-14 shooting at Northwest Nazarene, including a conference-record eight straight made three-pointers. Scored 25 points at Central Washington. Posted a 15-point, season-high 11-rebound double-double vs. Angelo State. Recorded 11 points vs. Indiana in the Great Alaska Shootout.
