**Pro Career Highlights:** Played with Ratiopharm Ulm in Germany in 2006-07, averaging 4.1 points in 16 games. Appeared in three games with the Nebraska Cranes in the USBL in the summer of 2006, averaging 11.7 points and 2.0 assists. Played briefly with KK Siroki Hercegtisak in the Adriatic League in 2005-06, scoring six points in two games.

**College Highlights:** Finished collegiate career at Auburn after playing first two seasons as Des Moines Area College in Iowa.

**Senior (2004-05):** Averaged 13.3 points (17<sup>th</sup> in the SEC) and 4.1 assists. Ranked second in the conference in free throw percentage (.865), tied for the third-best single season mark in school history. Season total of 70 made three-point field goals ranked as the seventh best single-season total in school history. Scored 20 or more points six times. Tied career high with 28 points, including 6-for-10 shooting from three-point range at Temple in the season opener. Sank five threes in scoring 22 points vs. Louisiana Tech. Scored 25 points vs. UNLV. Grabbed a career-high eight rebounds on four occasions. Dished out a career-high seven assists vs. Tennessee.

**Junior (2003-04):** Averaged 10.0 points, 2.4 assists, and 2.3 rebounds in 27.3 minutes a contest. Started 18 of 28 games. Registered season-high 28 points on 9-for-18 shooting (6-for-12 from beyond three-point range) vs. Alabama. Posted 21 points at LSU. Tallied 14 points and a season-high-matching seven assists vs. Arkansas. Led team with 13 points vs. Georgia. Sank 4-for-5 three-point field goals in scoring 16 points vs. Western Kentucky. Scored 13 points vs. Kentucky.

**Sophomore (2002-03):** Averaged 20.8 points, 5.1 rebounds, and 4.3 assists. Led Region XI in scoring and free throw percentage (.826), ranked third in assists, and sixth in three-point field goal percentage (.394). Tied a school record with 42 points vs. Waldorf. Helped lead DMACC to a 26-7 record. Named a Second Team NJCAA Division II All-American. Finished fifth in all-time scoring at Des Moines Area CC with 1,111 career points.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Averaged 13.3 points and 4.4 rebounds on his way to Second Team All-Conference honors. Helped team to a 31-6 record and a Region XI championship.

**Personal:** Only played one semester of high school basketball, the second semester of his senior season.
