College Highlights: Grabbed five or more rebounds in 30 career contests. Started 21 of 113 career games.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 1.4 points and 1.6 rebounds in 7.6 minutes a contest. Started once. Scored season-high seven points and grabbed three rebounds at Arizona State. Pulled down a season-high six rebounds in nine minutes vs. St. Mary's (Calif.). Hit all three field goal attempts in scoring six points vs. Virginia. Tallied six points and four rebounds vs. Stanford.

Redshirt Junior (2004-05): Averaged 2.0 points and 2.3 rebounds in 9.4 minute a contest. Started six times. Scored in double figures three times. Registered a season-high 11 points on 5-for-6 shooting vs. Manhattan. Posted ten points and a seaosn-high eight rebounds vs. Wright State. Scored ten points vs. Mississippi State.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 8.5 points and 6.5 rebounds in two appearances before suffering a season-ending knee injury. Registered first career double-double with a career-high 15 points and 11 rebounds vs. Northern Arizona. Granted a medical redshirt and an extra year of eligibility.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 3.6 points and 3.0 rebounds in 12.0 minutes a contest. Ranked second on the team in field goal percentage (.545). Started five times. Scored in double figures four times. Recorded season-high 12 points on 6-for-8 shooting at Oregon. Tallied eight points and a season-high ten rebounds at Oregon State. Hit all five field goal attempts in scoring ten points vs. St. Louis. Registered 11 points and eight rebounds vs. Texas.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 4.4 points and 4.0 rebounds in 15.2 minutes a contest. Started nine times. Scored in double figures twice. Shot 8-for-10 from the free throw line on his way to 12 points vs. Illinois. Recorded ten points and six rebounds at Washington State. Tallied eight points and a career-high 12 rebounds vs. Arizona State. Contributed eight points vs. Oklahoma in the Sweet Sixteen of the NCAA Tournament.

Personal: Majored in history. Was born the same day former Arizona head coach Lute Olson was hired. Father, Nils, lettered on the Arizona football team in 1983 and 1984.
