Senior (2006-07): Played and started in 33 games in his first year at Northern Kentucky averaging a career best 7.8 points, 4.2 rebounds in 21.6 minutes per contest.

Junior (2005-06): Played in 24 games earning nine starts averaging 2.6 points in 12.8 minutes per game.

Sophomore (2004-05): For the season, he played in 20 games, averaging 2.1 points and 1.0 rebounds. He was also named the 2005 winner of the John L. Macbeth Memorial Scholar-Athlete Award, which goes to the upperclassman on the team with the best cumulative GPA.

Freshman (2003-04): Cripe played in all 32 games in 2003-04, averaging 8.2 minutes a game as seniors Keith Waleskowski and Sean Finn closed out their careers. Cripe averaged 1.5 points and 1.5 rebounds in this role. Two of the strongest efforts for the Cincinnati native were against Xavier and Cincinnati. He had nine points and three rebounds in the win over Xavier at UD Arena, and had five points and four rebounds in a career-high 20 minutes at Cincinnati. He also had eight points and seven rebounds vs. Wofford
