Pro Career Highlights: Played with the Geraldton Buccaneers in the Skywest Basketball League in Australia in 2006-07, averaging a league-leading 32.3 points and 8.3 rebounds, 3.4 assists, and 2.5 steals.

College Highlights: Earned First Team All-Big Sky honors and was named conference Newcomer of the Year as a junior. Ranks as Sacramento State's fifth all-time leading scorer in its Division I history with 802 career points. Started 48 of 52 career games. Finished collegiate career at Sacramento State after playing first two seasons at Chaffey College in Rancho Cucamonga, Calif.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 13.2 points and 5.5 rebounds. Started 21 of 25 games. Scored 20 or more points five times, recording a season-high 25 points vs. Long Beach State. Posted three double-doubles, including a 22-point, ten-rebound performance vs. Denver. Scored 16 points and grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds at Montana. Tallied 21 points and seven rebounds at Boise State. Shot 8-for-11 from the field in scoring 21 points and grabbing eight rebounds at Eastern Washington.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 17.5 points and 4.6 rebounds. Set school Division I records for single season free throws made (157) and attempted (213). Started all 27 games. Scored 20 or more points 11 times. Registered a career-high 31 points, hitting 4-for-6 from beyond three-point range, and grabbed nine rebounds vs. Weber State. Tallied 24 points and a season-high 11 rebounds vs. UC Davis. Recorded 29 points, six rebounds, and a career-high six assists vs. Northern Arizona. Scored 25 points vs. Weber State in the first round of the Big Sky Tournament.
