**Pro Career Highlights:** Played with the Dodge City Legend in the USBL in the summer of 2007, averaging 8.4 points and 5.1 rebounds in eight games. Briefly spent time with Mersin Buyusehir Belediyesi in Turkey in 2006-07 and Jiangsu Nangang Dragons Nanjin in China in 2005-06, but did not play in any regular season games with either team. Participated in NBA summer league with the Orlando Magic in 2005.

**College Highlights:** Earned honorable mention All-Big 12 honors from the league coaches his junior and senior seasons. Finished collegiate career as the sixth all-time leader in blocked shots (103) in Texas history. Also ranks fifth all-time in games played (131) and tied the school record for NCAA Tournament games played (12). Started 27 of 131 career games.

**Senior (2004-05):** Averaged 11.2 points and 5.8 rebounds. Started 16 of 30 games. Scored in double figures 21 times. Posted three double-doubles. Registered first career double-double with ten points and a career-high 11 rebounds vs. Tennessee in the Maui Invitational. Scored 14 points in three consecutive games at Seton Hall, vs. North Texas, and vs. Texas-Arlington. Recorded a career-high seven blocked shots vs. Texas-San Antonio. Tallied 16 points, eight rebounds, and two blocks at Colorado. Posted 15 points, ten rebounds, three blocks, and three steals vs. Missouri. Scored 12 points and grabbed nine rebounds in the semifinals of the Big 12 Tournament. Set a career-high with 20 points and also tallied six rebounds and three blocked shots vs. Nevada in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Junior (2003-04):** Averaged 7.0 points and 3.9 rebounds in 16.7 minutes a contest. Started seven times. Scored in double figures nine times. Registered season-high 19 points on 9-for-13 shooting at Oklahoma State. Tallied ten points, seven rebounds, and three blocked shots at Texas A&M. Scored 13 points at Iowa State. Averaged 14.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in three games in the Big 12 Tournament. Scored 14 points and tied a season-high with eight rebounds vs. Kansas in the tournament semifinals. Led team with 15 points in the championship game vs. Oklahoma State. Posted ten points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Sophomore (2002-03):** Averaged 4.3 points and 3.0 rebounds in 12.9 minutes a contest. Started once. Scored in double figures twice, registering a season-high 15 points on 7-for-10 shooting vs. Texas A&M. Tallied ten points and five rebounds vs. Iowa State. Pulled down a season-high eight rebounds vs. Arizona. Blocked a season-high three shots at Kansas and at Colorado. Tallied six points and four rebounds vs. Connecticut in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Redshirt Freshman (2001-02):** Averaged 3.5 points and 3.2 rebounds in 11.9 minutes a contest. Started three times. Set season highs of nine points and eight rebounds vs. Nebraska. Registered eight points and five rebounds vs. Oregon State. Blocked a team-high four shots at UNLV. Tallied six points, five rebounds, and two blocks at Utah. Scored six points vs. Oregon in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.

**Freshman (2000-01):** Appeared in three games and did not score. Suffered a sprained right ankle and was granted a medical redshirt.
