Professional Career: 2008-09: Miami Heat: DNP, because of injury (a torn anterior cruciate ligament), left in October ... 2009-10: In September tested by PGE Turow Zgorzelec (Poland-PLK), but not signed.

College Highlights: Played in 128 career games at Davidson averaging 8.6 points in 24.4 minutes per game ... Davidson's all-time assist leader with 663; also holds school records for assists in a season (293) and assists in a game (19) ... Led the nation in assists as a senior (8.1/gm) and ranked second as a junior (7.3/gm) ... Graduated from Davidson with a bachelor's degree in history in 2008.

Senior (2007-08): Bob Cousy Award Nominee ... 1st Team All-SoCon (Media & Coaches) ... SoCon All-Tournament 1st Team ... First-team All-Midwest Regional in NCAA Tournament ... CollegelInsider.com SoCon Most Valuable Player ... CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major All-America Team ... 1st Team All-State (NCCSIA) ... Compiled 10 or more assists in a contest 10 times ... Recorded seven double-doubles (points, assists) ... Tallied his 1,000th career point against Appalachian State (2/27) ... Became the third player in Davidson history to tally 500 career assists after registering eight helpers at Furman (1/16) ... Recorded his second double-double of the season with 14 points and 11 assists against No. 7 Duke ... Keyed the Bracketbuster win at Winthrop (2/22) with a game-high 21 points, including five buckets from downtown ... Compiled a season-high 24 points against App. State on Senior Night (2/27) at Belk Arena ... Had 20 points, including 9-of-10 from the free-throw line, in the 'Cats' win over Georgetown (3/23) to advance to the Sweet 16 ... Recorded 13 assists with no turnovers and added 11 points against Wisconsin in the NCAA Tournament regional semifinals ... Had seven points and nine assists in the regional final against Kansas.

Junior (2006-07): Voted All-SoCon by league head coaches and 2nd Team All-SoCon by the media ... Ranked 2nd nationally in total assists and assists per game ... Led the SoCon in assists, assists per game and assist/turnover ratio ... Second on the club with an average of 13.5 points per game ... His 52 steals and 81.1 percent clip from the free throw line ranked him second on the team in both categories ... Named SoCon Player of the Week and CollegelInsiders.com Player of the Week for the week of Dec. 19 ... Reached double figures in 25 of the Wildcats' 33 games ... Had six contests where he handed out 10 or more assists ... Recorded three double-doubles via points and assists ... Earned MVP honors at the Arizona State Holiday Tournament; tallied 18 points and dished out eight assists in the opening win over Ohio and scored 25 points in the championship game while playing 39 minutes ... Scored 20 points in both the quarterfinals and semifinals of the 2007 SoCon Tournament, earning All-Tournament recognition.

Sophomore (2005-06): Played in 31 games, averaged 4.5 points and hit 49 percent of his shots from the field, plus 81.6 percent from the line ... Had 92 assists, which was second on the team ...
