College Highlights: played in 118 games in his four-year career at Wyoming earning 110 starts ... averaged 13.1 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3.83 assists in 32.0 minutes per game.

Senior (2004-05): played in 28 games and earned 28 starts in his final season at Wyoming ... averaged 18.0 points 3.9 rebounds and 5.2 assists in 39.6 minutes per game ... scored 20 points or more in nine games his senior year ... scored a career high 41 points on Feb. 26, 2005, at Colorado State ... selected Second Team All-District 13 by the National Association of Basketball Coaches ... one of only two players in the Mountain West Conference to rank in the top five in the MWC in points, assists and steals for the 2004-05 season ... scored in double figures in 27 of 28 games his senior season, and in 78 of 118 career games.

Junior (2003-04): played in 27 games earning 23 starts and averaged 15.7 points in 31.2 minutes per game ... scored in double figures in 23 of 27 games during his junior campaign ... set a new UW single-game record for assists, with 15 against Winthrop on Dec. 20 ... earned MWC Player of the Week honors on Feb. 2, 2004, after he posted two of the three highest scoring games of his career in back-to-back games, scoring a career high 30 vs. San Diego State on Jan. 26, 2004, and followed that up with a 26-point performance at CSU on Jan. 31.

Sophomore (2002-03): an Honorable Mention All-Mountain West Conference selection as a sophomore ... played in 32 games earning 32 starts and averaged 10.5 points in 29.9 minutes per game ... he led the Cowboys in assists, averaging 3.09 assists per game ... scored in double figures in 17 of 32 games, including three 20-point games -- a season high 27 at Air Force on Feb. 17, 2003; 22 vs. CSU on Jan. 25, 2003; and 20 vs. CSU on Feb. 22, 2003, he was named MWC Player of the Week following that three-game stretch ... Straight earned the Barry Crater Sportsmanship Award at the 2002 Wyoming Shootout, helping lead UW to a 67-62 victory over Texas Tech.

Freshman (2001-02): named Co-Freshman of the Year by Mountain West Conference coaches, and The Sporting News named him its MWC Freshman of the Year ... one of only 16 freshmen nationally to be selected to CollegeInsider.com's All-Freshman Team at the conclusion of the 2001-02 season ... averaged 9.2 points per game, 2.4 rebounds and 3.3 assists... Straight started 27 of Wyoming's 31 games, including the last 26 consecutive ... the true freshman led UW in assists and ranked fifth on the team in scoring.
