Senior (2007-08): Averaged 8.4 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 2.7 assists. Started all 34 games. Scored in double figures 11 times. Posted career-high 23 points and eight rebounds at USC and scored 14 points in the rematch. Tallied 14 points and five assists vs. Washington State. Registered 12 points and a career-high three blocks at UNLV. Recorded 19 points on 7-for-9 shooting at Washington. Dished out a career-high seven assists in games vs. San Diego State and Cal.

Junior (2006-07): Averaged 9.6 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 1.7 assists. Started 21 of 30 games. Scored in double figures 14 times, topping the 20-point mark twice. Set season-high of 22 points on 7-for-9 shooting vs. New Mexico State. Matched season-high of 22 points on 7-for-10 shooting and dished out a season-high four assists at Washington. Tallied 18 points in the season opener at Virginia. Recorded 12 points and a career-high nine rebounds vs. Samford. Notched 12 points and six rebounds vs. Purdue in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore (2005-06): Made two appearances, starting once, scoring a total of eight points and grabbing three rebounds. Sat out the fall semester while academically ineligible and then had season-ending surgery on his left wrist to repair a torn ligament in late January. Scored all eight points of the year in his season debut at Oregon State.

Freshman (2004-05): Averaged 5.8 points and 3.0 rebounds in 15.5 minutes a contest. Scored in double figures seven times. Registered season-high 19 points vs. Wyoming. Tallied 11 points and a season-high eight rebounds vs. Wake Forest. Recorded 14 points on 6-for-8 shooting vs. Cal in the first round of the Pac-10 Tournament. Tallied 15 points on 6-for-7 shooting and grabbed five rebounds vs. Oregon State in the semifinals. Scored ten points vs. Illinois in the NCAA Tournament Regional Finals.
