Senior (2008-09): NCAA III West Region Player of the Year ... led the Pioneers to a 23-6 record and the team's first NCAA Division III playoff berth since 1999 ... scored 20 points in leading UW-Platteville to 84-79 win at NCAA Division I Bradley ... became 30th Pioneer to score 1,000 points during 66-64 win at Anderson (Ind.) ... named tournament MVP at UW-Platteville Tip-Off Classic and made all-tournament team at Hanover ... twice earned the WIAC Player of the Week Award and once was on the D3hoops.com Team of the Week ... scored in double figures 24 times ... has scored 15 or more in 21 games. Pioneers are 20-1 when Skemp scores at least 15 points ... has shot better than 50% from the floor in 21 games.

Junior (2007-08): Returned from knee surgery as a junior and played and started in 26 contests averaging 15.2 points, 8.3 rebounds in 29.1 minutes.

Junior (2006-07): had season-ending knee surgery Dec. 23 and will miss the remainder of the season. Played in eight games prior to the injury and averaged 12.5 minutes 24.3 minutes per game.

Sophomore (2005-06): Skemp began the year with 14-point performance at UW-Milwaukee, one year after dropping 16 on the Wisconsin Badgers ... earned all-tournament honors at Pioneer Tip-Off Tournament after scoring 17 points and grabbing eight rebounds and dishing out six assists ... led the team in scoring four times, including a career-high 22 points against Mary Hardin-Baylor ... led the team in rebounds 11 times, with career-best 11 against UW-Stout ... had three double-doubles on the year ... scored in doubles digits 14 times, and had double digits in rebounds three times ... scored two free throws with 15.6 seconds left in 66-65 win over UW-Stevens Point ... had five blocked shots against Mary Hardin-Baylor ... scored game-high 21 points in 92-88 win over USK Praha in Prague and hit game-winning shot with 10 seconds left in 88-86 win over Salzburg All-Stars.

Freshman (2004-05): scored a game-high 16 points against the Wisconsin Badgers, including a dunk right after Alando Tucker dunked on the other end of the Kohl Center ... reached double figures five times, including 17 at UW-La Crosse, where he scored the final 4 points in a 52-50 win ... shot 62.8 percent in UWP wins ... blocked three shots on four occasions and ranked fifth in the WIAC with 28 blocks ... made 5-6 from the field, finishing with 14 points and 7 rebounds in 77-42 win over UW-Superior
