College Highlights: Named Second Team All-Region by Daktronics. Earned First Team All-Gulf South Conference honors his junior and senior seasons. Participated in the NABC NCAA Division II All-Star game. Ranks as Delta State's 14th all-time leading scorer with 1,001 points. Also ranks fifth all-time in three-point field goals made (120). Finished collegiate career at Delta State after playing first two seasons at Copiah-Lincoln Community College in Wesson, Mississippi.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 17.8 points (ranked ninth in the GSC) and 5.0 rebounds. Led team in three-point field goals made (65). Started all 31 games. Scored 20 or more points 12 times. Posted career-high 34 points at Central State. Posted a double-double of 24 points and 12 rebounds vs. Arkansas-Monticello. Scored 27 points, sinking five three-pointers, and grabbed six rebounds vs. Miles College. Tallied 25 points, four rebounds, and a season-high six assists vs. Tougaloo. Registered 21 points and five rebounds vs. Stillman College in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Recorded 17 points and six rebounds vs. Arkansas-Monticello in the second round.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 15.0 points and 4.2 rebounds. Led team in three-point field goals made and ranked second in free throws made. Started 29 of 30 games. Scored in double figures 17 times. Recorded 26 points vs. Arkansas Baptist. Led team with 21 points vs. North Alabama. Scored 17 points and pulled down a season-high nine rebounds vs. Arkansas Tech. Recorded a season-high 33 points vs. Harding in the first round of the Gulf South Tournament. Scored a team-high 17 points vs. West Georgia in the semifinals, and paced the team with 18 points vs. Montevallo in the championship game.

Sophomore (2003-04): At Copiah-Lincoln, averaged 18 points, six rebounds, and three assists. Earned All-Region and All-State honors.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 9.4 points and 2.6 assists.
