College Highlights: Enjoyed two of the best seasons to open his career in the history of the school ... Really athletic player who plays longer than his frame ... Can play the No. 1 or No. 2 guard ... Explosive around the basket ... Possesses long arms that can get in the passing lanes well.

Junior (2008-09): Selected to All-Conference USA Third Team ... Scored 28 points on 10-of-15 shooting against UAB in Conference USA Tournament Semifinal loss (3/4) ... Scored 26 points on 10-of-15 shooting at SMU (3/4) ... Recorded second career double-double, scoring 17 points while dishing out a season-high 10 assists against East Carolina (2/17) ... Led team with 15 points and six assists versus Memphis (2/14) ... Recorded a season-high nine assists at UTEP (1/31) ... Dished out eight assists versus Montana State (1/24) ... Dropped in 20 points while recording seven rebounds and five assists at Tulane (1/14) ... Scored 17 points and grabbed six rebounds against Ole Miss (12/30) ... Scored 19 points and recorded six assists against Weber State (12/23) ... Recorded a season-high eight assists against Spring Hill (12/22) ... Hit a Conference USA record 19-of-19 free throws, while scoring 21 points, against McNeese State (12/18) ... Had a game-high seven rebounds at New Mexico (12/6) ... Captured a season-high 28 points and six assists while setting a career-high in steals (6) against South Alabama (12/2) ... Named to the Paradise Jam All-Tournament Team, averaging 20.7 points, 3.3 rebounds and 4.7 assists ... Scored a team-high 26 points, while grabbing eight rebounds against Alabama State (11/18) ... Led team with 23 points, while pulling down five rebounds against Loyola (N.O.) (11/15)

Sophomore (2007-08): Earned Honorable Mention All-American honors by Collegehoops.net ... Named Second Team All-Conference USA ... The only Golden Eagle to start all 33 games ... Scored in double-figures in 31 of 33 contests, including the final 15 games ... Scoring average of 18.7 points per game ranked fifth in C-USA ... Became just the third player ever to score over 600 points in a season, and the first since Clarence Weatherspoon in 1991-92 ... His 617 points ranked second all-time at the school for sophomores ... Scored 22 points against SMU, becoming the 31st Golden Eagle to score 1,000 points in a career ... Ranked seventh in C-USA with an .818 free throw percentage ... Hit 198 free throws rank second all-time at Southern Miss for a season, while his 115 in conference play tied the Conference USA record ... Scored 20 points or more 13 times, including a career-high 33 points at Alabama, his first 30-point outing (11/23) ... Led the team in scoring a team-high 14 times ... Recorded his first career double-double, scoring 12 points with 12 assists at East Carolina (2/16) ... Led the team in assists a team-high 25 times ... Scored 29 points against Louisiana Tech in the opening game of the Mississippi Coast Classic (12/18).

Freshman (2006-07): Earned freshman All-American honors by collegeinsider.com as well as the High-Major Freshman of the Year by the Collegehoops.net ... Earned C-USA Freshman and Newcomer of the Year honors as well ... The only Golden Eagle to start in every game ... Scored in double digits in 29 of 31 contests, including 22 straight to end the campaign ... Ranked No. 4 in C-USA at 17.5 points per contest ... His scoring average was the best-ever for a freshman at Southern Miss ... Also ranks first all-time for freshmen scorers at the school with 541 points ... First Golden Eagle to score at least 500 points in a season since Neil Reed (1998-99) tallied 506 points ... Ranked No. 4 in free throw shooting in C-USA ... Had 10 games of scoring 20 or more points, including a season-high 28 at Memphis (1/27).
